- **Connect**—Join our ListServe to receive the latest news and critical information for meeting program requirements.
- **Communicate**—Reach out to us by phone, email, or screen-sharing for help in quality reporting. We can even set up an appointment for you, if you prefer.
- **Control**—Manage the various aspects of quality reporting by having key staff members responsible for reporting activities. Besides keeping up with these activities, become familiar with other program processes, such as to submit an [Extraordinary Circumstances Exceptions \(ECE\)](#) request or a [Reconsideration](#) request.
- **Change**—Account for staff turnover and include quality reporting activities in your new employee orientation. If someone leaves, find out what role they played in these activities and assign those functions to other staff.
