## CY 2018 (FY 2020) Available Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs)

For calendar year (CY) 2018 reporting (fiscal year [FY] 2020 payment determination), hospitals participating in the Hospital IQR Program and the Medicare Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program are required to successfully submit data for at least **four (4) of the 15 eCQMs available**, as shown below, using any combination of Quality Reporting Document Architecture (QRDA) Category I files, zero denominator declarations, and/or case threshold exemptions that reflect the hospital's total inpatient population. These data must be reported using health information technology (IT) certified by the Office of the National Coordinator for Health IT (ONC) to the 2014 Edition, the 2015 Edition, or a combination of both.
