Rationale: Updates the version number and the effective date to enable users to determine which Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) manual is relevant to the discharge period in question.

Impacts: Table 1: Specification Resources for IPFQR Program Measures

Rationale: Provides updated URLs to access the *Specifications Manual for Joint Commission National Quality Measures* and the IPFQR Program Claims-Based Measure Specifications.

Description of Changes:

Rationale: Provides updates to ensure users can abstract data appropriately for the SUB-2/-2a and TOB-2/-2a measures for calendar year 2022 discharges.

Description of Changes:

Changed the text in the third paragraph on page 20 below the SUB-2: Alcohol Use Brief Intervention Provided or Offered and the subset SUB-2a: Alcohol Use Brief Intervention sub-header to:

"The **denominator** for the SUB-2 measure is the number of hospital inpatients 18 years of age and older who screen positive for unhealthy alcohol use or an alcohol use disorder (alcohol abuse or alcohol dependence). The SUB-2a **denominator** is the same as that of the SUB-2 measure but excludes those who were screened with a non-validated tool within the first day of admission (by end of Day 1) and those not screened for alcohol use within the first day of admission (by end of Day 1), or it was unable to be determined from medical record documentation. Both measures exclude patients who are less than 18 years of age, are cognitively impaired, who refused to be screened for alcohol use during the hospital stay, or who have Comfort Measures Only documented. Exclusions based on LOS are determined using the current *Specifications Manual*."

Changed the text in the fourth paragraph on page 21 below the TOB-2: Tobacco Use Treatment Provided or Offered and the subset TOB-2a: Tobacco Use Treatment subheader to:

"The **denominator** for the TOB-2 measure includes the number of hospitalized patients 18 years of age and older identified as current tobacco users. The TOB-2a **denominator** is the same as that of the TOB-2 measure but excludes those whose tobacco use status is unknown. Both measures exclude patients who are less than 18 years of age, are cognitively impaired, are not current tobacco users, who refused screening for tobacco use during the hospital stay, or who have Comfort Measures Only documented. Exclusions based on LOS are determined using the current *Specifications Manual.*"
