- ASC-10 (Endoscopy/Polyp Surveillance: Colonoscopy Interval for Patients with a History of Adenomatous Polyps Avoidance of Inappropriate Use)

You also remember that you need an active Security Administrator or Basic User with the data entry role, and you need the data for these measures collected from 2015 encounters.
