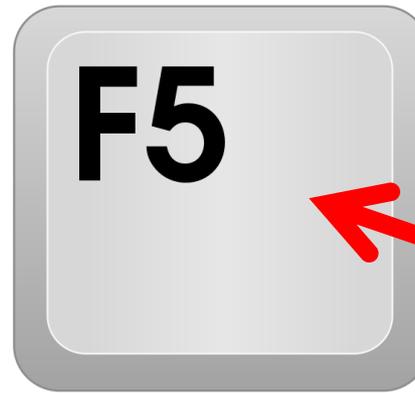


# Troubleshooting Audio

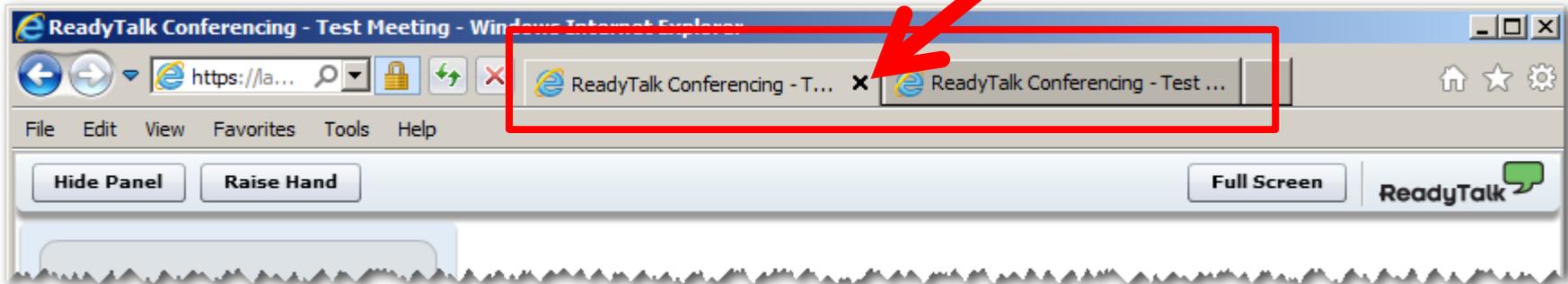

**CMS announces steps to address CDI risk-adjustment error**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has identified an error with the risk-adjustment for the First and Second Quarter 2014 *Clostridium difficile* Infection (CDI) data.

CMS has announced steps to resolve the data issue for hospitals participating in each of the three programs impacted by the error: the Hospital-Acquired Condition (HAC) Reduction Program, the Hospital Value-Based Purchasing (VBP) Program, and the Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting (IQR) Program.







### eCQM Electronic Specifications

These electronic specifications are fully developed and represent the electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs) that will be proposed in 2016 for the ambulatory and inpatient hospital quality reporting programs. This page will be updated if changes are made to the final measure requirements.

Each year, CMS makes updates to the electronic specifications of the Clinical Quality Measures approved for submission in CMS programs. CMS encourages the implementation and use of the updates because they include new codes, logic corrections and clarifications. Below are Eligible Professionals (EP) and Eligible Hospitals (EH) electronic measure specifications and companion resources to support implementation.

For those attesting to eCQMs to demonstrate meaningful use for the EHR Incentive Programs:

- CMS will accept all versions of the eCQMs through attestation, beginning with those finalized in the December 4, 2012 CMS-ONC Interim Final Rule.
- For eReporting of eCQMs to demonstrate meaningful use or for Quality Reporting Programs:
- An eligible professional, eligible hospital or Critical Access Hospital must use the most current version of the eCQMs identified for each program below.

The vocabulary value sets used by eCQMs consist of codes and terms drawn from standard vocabularies such as SNOMED CT®, RxNorm, and ICD-10-CM to represent the clinical concepts found in EHR patient data as defined by the eCQMs (e.g., patients with diabetes, clinical visit). Providers must ensure their health IT systems either capture or can map to these codes in order to report eCQMs.

To obtain the value sets for the eCQMs, you can download packages in multiple file formats from the "Downloads" page at the [Value Set Authority Center \(VSAC\)](#). The value sets are available as a complete set, as well as value sets per measure. You will be required to login with [Unified Medical Language System® Metathesaurus License](#) credentials, also available through the VSAC website. The [Data Element Catalog](#), an additional resource linked on the VSAC home page, contains the complete list of updated eCQMs and value set names.






