

The Prospective Payment System (PPS)-Exempt Cancer Hospital Qua was developed as mandated by Section 3005 of the Affordable Care

The PCHQR program is intended to equip consumers with quality-of-cinformed decisions about healthcare options. It is also intended to ento improve the quality of inpatient care provided to Medicare beneficiare aware of and reporting on best practices for their respective facili

To meet the PCHQR Program requirements, PPS- Exempt Cancer Hos submit all quality measures to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid S Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 payment determination year. Participating facil program requirements set forth, including public reporting of the measurements.


PCHQR Program Eligibility

Eligible hospitals are described in section 1886(d)(1)(B)(v) and refer Hospital or PCH. These hospitals are excluded from payment under tl System (IPPS). CMS has designated 11 hospitals as <u>PPS-Exempt Can</u> Excluded Cancer Hospitals).


Final Rules for Hospital Inpatient Prospective Payment System Information regarding the PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospital Quality Reportion found in the following final rule publications.

- In the FY 2013 Inpatient Prospective Payment System and Long Payment System or IPPS/LTCH final rule (77 FR 53556 through 5 & Medicaid Services (CMS) finalized five quality measures (two he and three cancer-specific treatment measures) for the FY 2014 pt
- In the <u>FY 2014 IPPS/LTCH PPS</u> final rule (78 FR 50838 through 50 additional new HAI quality measure (surgical site infection) for th subsequent years. In addition, CMS finalized 12 new quality measures oncology care measures for the FY 2016 program and sul remove or replace any of the previously finalized measures from and FY 2016.
- In the <u>FY 2015 IPPS/LTCH PPS final rule</u> (79 FR 50277), CMS final effectiveness measure (EBRT) for the FY 2017 program and subscremove or replace any of the previously finalized measures from 2017 program and subsequent years.





All users requesting access to the QualityNet Secure Portal (formerly, My QualityNet) must be individually approved and verified. This mandatory registration process is used to maintain the confidentiality and security of healthcare information and data transmitted via the Secure Portal. The process begins with registration for a QualityNet account.

For registration instructions, select your user classification below:

Security Administrator

The QualityNet Security Administrator facilitates the registration process for other users at the organization. Typically, an organization designates two Security Administrators. See the <u>Security Administrator Responsibilities</u> for a more complete list of duties. Providers submitting data (or using a vendor to submit data on their behalf) and accessing secured reports via the QualityNet Secure Portal are **required** to designate a Security Administrator.

Basic User

All other registered QualityNet users in an organization are considered basic users.

Data submission vendor

Joint Commission-certified Performance Measurement Systems or other third-party data submission vendors wishing to transmit data via the QualityNet Secure Portal must also register for a QualityNet account. Contact the QualityNet Help Desk to obtain a Vendor ID and initiate the registration process.

Each hospital should have at least two team members registered as SAs.

Important Reminders for Hospitals Regarding SAs


Each hospital should have at least two QualityNet SAs.

 This is important for backup in the event of illness, vacations, or position status changes during a data submission period.

SAs must log into QualityNet at least every 60 days to keep their account active.

- If an SA (or other QualityNet user) has not logged in for more than 60 days, their account may be deactivated.
 - This could pose a problem during a data submission period.





Measure Exception Form

Some hospitals may not have locations that meet the National Healthcare Safety criteria for CLABSI or CAUTI reporting, and some hospitals may perform so few pi surveillance under the SSI measure that the data may not be meaningful for Hosp sufficiently reliable to be utilized for quality reporting purposes in a program year.

Reporting will not be required for these measures if the PPS-Exempt Cancer Hosp than a combined total of nine specified colon and abdominal hysterectomy proced year prior to the reporting year. To indicate a measure is not being reported, a MI Form should be completed and submitted prior to the First Quarter data submission applicable program year.


Extraordinary Circumstances Extension/Exemptions Request Form

In the event that a PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospital (PCH) is unable to submit any re-(e.g., medical records, data) due to an extraordinary circumstance, such as a nat PCH may request an extension or waiver. The PCH will need to complete the Extraction: Exemptions Request Form and submit the form with any information and supporting documentation within 30 calendar days of the date of circumstance. 



PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospital Quality Reporting (PCHQR) Program

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) contracted with the American College of Surgeons (ACoS) to plan and implement the reporting of three cancer-specific care measures to CMS on behalf of the 11 PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospitals (PCH) through its Rapid Quality Reporting System (RQRS).

ACoS has formed the PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospital Workgroup (CHW) to:

- provide advice and feedback on the operational expectations of the PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospital Quality Reporting (PCHQR) Program
- discuss and identify solutions to possible barriers and/or challenges encountered by the PCHs in their implementation and use of the RQRS
- . communicate and share updates regarding data submission requirements and time-lines
- · identify any anticipated potential unintended consequences of the Reporting Program

The CHW, which comprises leadership representatives from each of the PCHs, serves as an advisory committee on areas for additional review and study regarding the implementation and operationalization of measure reporting requirements relative to the stakeholder environment. Areas of expertise of the workgroup members include: data quality, oncology research and development, hospital and physician performance, data analytics, data warehousing, quality and performance improvement, pharmacy administration and project management.


CHW Meetings
