Question 1:

If the leaders in our organization who used to sign the DACA form do not have access to *Quality Net*, who should electronically sign the DACA? I am a quality analyst who submits my organizations data. Can I sign the DACA?

CMS recommends the hospital Chief Executive Officer (CEO) (who is ultimately responsible) or an authorized representative with the proper role (i.e., PCHQR Web-Based MSR DACA Update) complete this requirement. Therefore, if you have been assigned the proper role, you are able to sign the DACA. By doing so, you are attesting that the data submitted are accurate and complete to the best of your knowledge.
