Rationale and Clinical Recommendation Statements – NQF #0390

 - Research studies have shown with androgen deprivation therapy in combination with EBRT:
 - Patients can live longer and have lower risk of recurrence.
 - Cost-effectiveness and quality-adjusted life years increase.
 - Utilization rates have increased, but they still remain suboptimal.
- Clinical rationale statements updates
 - Recommended options for patients at very high risk:
 - Option for EBRT plus ADT and docetaxel has been removed.
 - Radical prostatectomy plus PLND is for **younger, healthier** patients with no **tumor** fixation to the **pelvic side wall**.
 - ADT **or observation** is for patients not **candidates** for definitive therapy.


