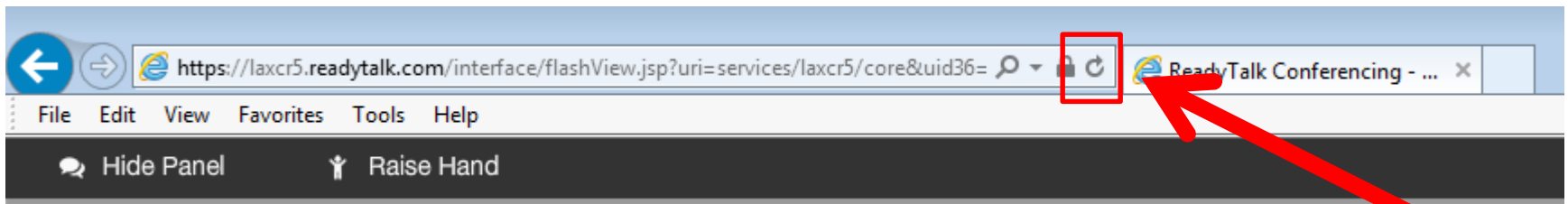

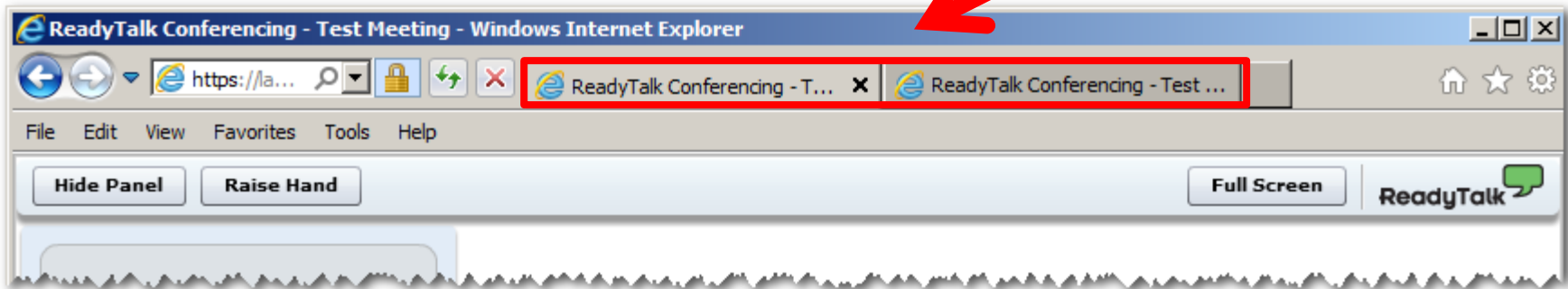

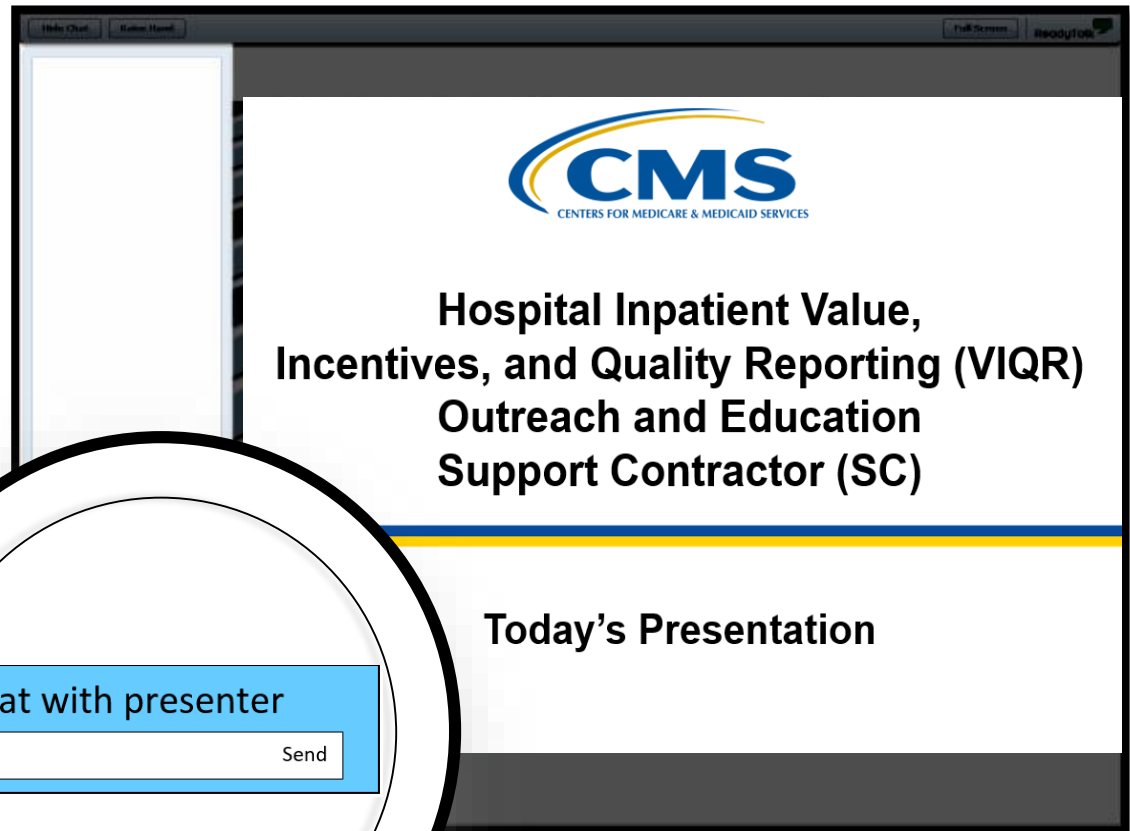

 - Obtain a *QualityNet* user account.
 - Register for access to the *QualityNet Secure Portal*.
- This mandatory registration process is used to maintain the confidentiality and security of healthcare information and data transmitted via the *QualityNet Secure Portal*.
- This CMS-approved site for secure healthcare quality data exchange enables facility reporting.

All users requesting access to the QualityNet Secure Portal (formerly, *My QualityNet*) must be individually approved and verified. This mandatory registration process is used to maintain the confidentiality and security of healthcare information and data transmitted via the Secure Portal. The process begins with registration for a QualityNet account.

For registration instructions, select your user classification below:

- **Security Administrator**
The QualityNet Security Administrator facilitates the registration process for other users at the organization. Typically, an organization designates two Security Administrators. You will need the static Credential ID and the dynamic Security Code generated by this application to complete your enrollment.

3. Click **Start/Complete New User Enrollment** in the yellow **Help** box.
4. Follow the six-step process to verify your identity. You will use the PreciseID service from Experian, an external service selected by CMS, to confirm your identity by providing personal information via a safe, encrypted process that, in turn, produces verification questions. 5. After completing identity verification, enter the **Credential ID** and the **Security Code** (within 30 seconds) generated by the Symantec VIP Access application. This will link your QualityNet user ID to your Symantec VIP Access credential.

SA Responsibilities

The PCH *QualityNet* SA is responsible for:

- Creating, approving, editing, and/or terminating *QualityNet* user accounts for the PCH.
- Assigning user roles for basic users within the PCH in order to ensure users' access to the secure web-based applications.
- Monitoring *QualityNet* usage at the PCH to ensure security and confidentiality are maintained.
- Serving as the point of contact at the PCH for information regarding *Quality Net*.

The quarters included in FY 2020 Inpatient Validation are third quarter 2017 (3Q17), fourth quarter 2017 (4Q17), first quarter 2018 (1Q18), and second quarter 2018 (2Q18). Is Your SA Registration Complete?

***QualityNet* SA Registration Forms Checklist**

Validate the following tasks have been completed to avoid delays in processing your registration:

- ✓ All required fields have been completed on the *QualityNet* Security Administrator Registration Form.
- ✓ The *QualityNet* Security Administrator Registration Form has been signed by the applicant.
- ✓ The highest-level executive at the organization has completed the *QualityNet* Security Administrator Authorization Form.
- ✓ Verify that you have obtained the correct address for mailing your completed forms. (See the table on page 2 for mailing instructions.)
- ✓ Verify that the forms are original. Photocopies and faxes of the completed forms will not be accepted.

SA 101

- It is a PCHQR Program requirement to have at least one **active** *QualityNet* SA.
 - CMS highly recommends designating a minimum of two *QualityNet* SAs.
- The SA registration process is required for each individual user.
 - SA rights/designations are not transferrable.

Common SA Account Statuses: Expiring Soon vs. Expired

- SA Expiring Soon:
 - **Issue:** Your current password is due to expire.
 - **Required Action:** You will need to log into *QualityNet* by the password expiration date and change/reset your password.
- SA Expired:
 - **Issue:** You have not logged in or changed your password in *QualityNet* for 60 days.
 - **Required Action:** You will need log into *QualityNet* and create a new password.

When To Contact the *QualityNet* Help Desk...

- If you go 120 days, or four months, without logging in or changing your password, you will be inactivated and you or your SA will need to contact the Help Desk to initiate a ticket to reactivate your status.

To achieve Meaningful Use and avoid penalties, providers must follow a set of criteria that serves as a roadmap for effectively using an EHR.
