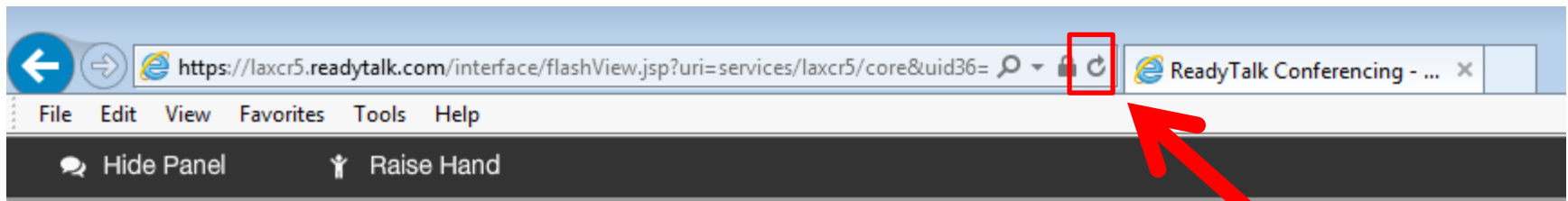

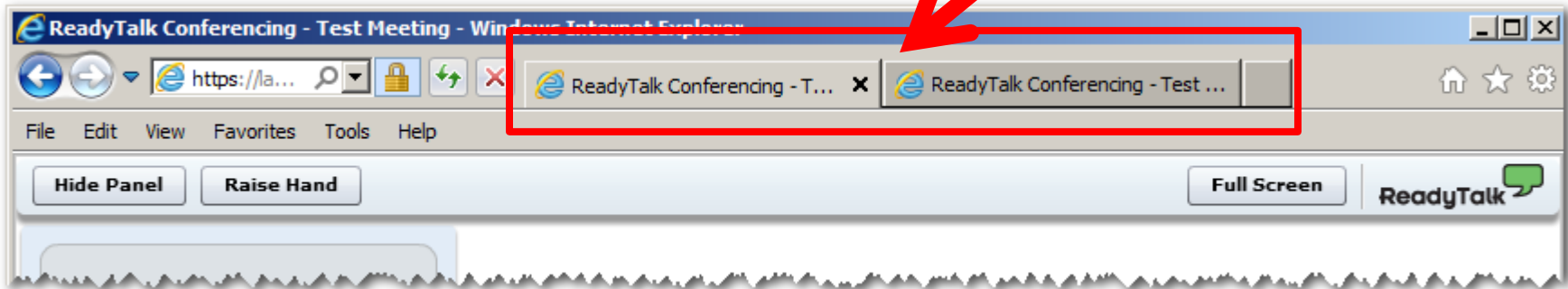

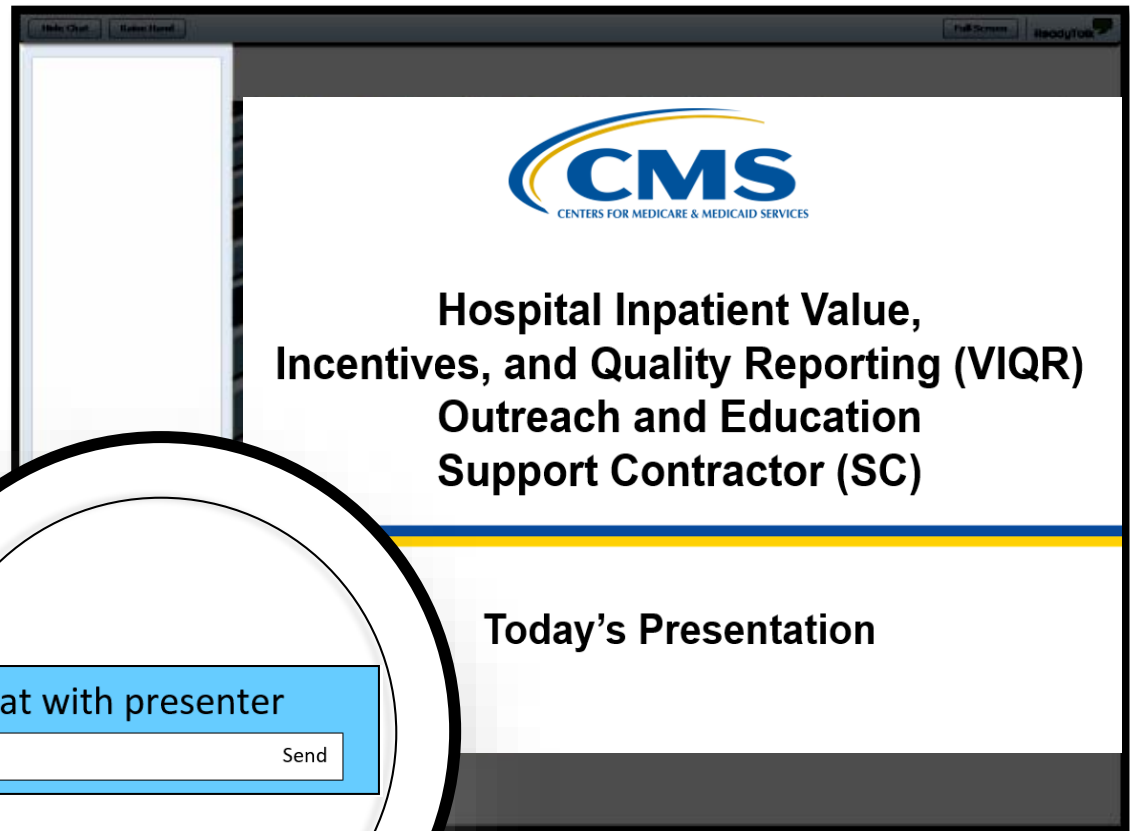

Purpose

This presentation will provide a review of the August 15, 2018 data submission of the Cancer-Specific Treatment (CST), Oncology Care Measures (OCMs), External Beam Radiotherapy (EBRT) measures, along with the August 31, 2018 electronic submission of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Data Accuracy and Completeness Acknowledgement (DACA). Submission of these requirements via the *QualityNet Secure Portal* will be reexamined.

Objectives

At the culmination of this educational program, participants will be able to meet the data entry submission requirements for the CST, OCM, and EBRT measures and successfully submit the FY 2019 DACA.





Population and Sampling Tips

- If you select “Not Sampled” for Sampling Frequency, your Initial Patient Population, sample size, and denominator should all be equal for PCH-14, PCH-15, PCH-16, and PCH-25.
 - This may not be true for PCH-17 and PCH-18 (prostate measures) due to numerator (post-denominator) exclusions.
- If your Initial Patient Population is ≤ 10 , sampling is not allowed, and you should select “Not Sampled” for Sampling Frequency.
