


Claims-Based Measures

- Quality Data Codes (QDCs)
 - ASC-1: Patient Burn
 - ASC-2: Patient Fall
 - ASC-3: Wrong Site, Wrong Side, Wrong Patient, Wrong Procedure, Wrong Implant
 - ASC-4: All-Cause Hospital Transfer/Admission
- Outcome Measure
 - ASC-12: Facility 7-Day Risk-Standardized Hospital Visit Rate after Outpatient Colonoscopy

Reminder

- ASC-1 through ASC-4 have been suspended beginning with Payment Determination Year 2021.
- For the current Payment Determination Year, you will need to comply with the 50% threshold for QDCs on claims.
 - Run a Provider Participation Report (PPR) to ensure compliance.

Web-Based Status Listing (PY 2020)

The Web-Based Measure Status Listing is provided as a quick way to determine if your facility has completed data submission using a web-based tool for the following measures for the Ambulatory Surgical Center Quality Reporting (ASCQR) Program:

- ASC-9: Endoscopy/Polyp Surveillance: Appropriate Follow-up Interval for Normal Colonoscopy in Average Risk Patients
- ASC-10: Endoscopy/Polyp Surveillance: Colonoscopy Interval for Patients with a History of Adenomatous Polyps
 Avoidance of Inappropriate Use
- ASC-11: Cataracts Improvement in Patient's Visual Function within 90 Days Following Cataract Surgery (Voluntary)
- · ASC-13: Normothermia
- · ASC-14: Unplanned Anterior Vitrectomy

Data submission for these measures is required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) in order to be eligible for the calendar year (CY) 2020 payment determination. ASCs may voluntarily submit data for ASC-11 and are not subject to a payment reduction during the voluntary reporting period.
