#### Preview User Interface (UI) Access

##### Preview Period

Preview data will be available to participating IPFs via the *QualityNet Secure Portal* **October 19 through November 18, 2021**.

##### Access Preview Data

1. Navigate to the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) page:  
<https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrmg/login>
2. Enter your Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) User ID and Password. Select **Login**.
3. You will see the **Two-Factor Authorization page**. Select **Text** or **Email**. Select **Continue**.
4. Enter the code you received and select **Continue**.
5. Read the Terms and Conditions statement. Select **Accept** to proceed. You will see the **HQR Landing** page. Note: If Cancel is selected, the program closes.
6. On the **HQR Landing** page, hover over the Lock Menu on the left side.
7. Select **Program Reporting**.
8. From the drop-down menu, select **Public Reporting**.
9. The page will refresh, and the data will be available to preview.

**READM-30-IPF** (Rate of readmission after discharge from hospital)

- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020 HBIPS-5** (Patients Discharged on Multiple Antipsychotic Medications with Appropriate Justification)
- **Data Reported: Q3 2019–Q4 2019 FUH-7** (Follow-up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness, 7-Days)
- **Data Reported: Q3 2019–Q4 2019 FUH-30** (Follow-up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness, 30-Days)
- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020 TR1** (Transition Record with Specified Elements Received by Discharged Patients)
- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020 TR2** (Timely Transmission of Transition Record)
- **Data Reported: Q3 2018–Q4 2019 MedCont** (Medication Continuation Following Inpatient Psychiatric Discharge)

##### Substance Use Treatment Measures

- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020**
  - **SUB-2** (Alcohol Use Brief Intervention Provided or Offered) and the subset **SUB-2a** (Alcohol Use Brief Intervention)
  - **TOB-2** (Tobacco Use Treatment Provided or Offered) and the subset **TOB-2a** (Tobacco Use Treatment during the hospital stay)

- **TOB-3** (Tobacco Use Treatment Provided or Offered at Discharge) and the subset **TOB-3a** (Tobacco Use Treatment at Discharge)
- **SUB-3** (Alcohol and other Drug Use Disorder Treatment Provided or Offered at Discharge) and the subset **SUB-3a** (Alcohol and other Drug Use Disorder Treatment Provided at Discharge)

##### Patient Safety Measures

- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020:**
  - **HBIPS-2** (Hours of Physical Restraint Use)
  - **HBIPS-3** (Hours of Seclusion Use)

##### Preventative Care and Screening Measures

- **Data Reported: Q1 2020–Q4 2020 SMD** (Screening for Metabolic Disorders)
- **Data Reported: Q4 2020–Q1 2021**  
**IPFQR-IMM-2** (Influenza Immunization)
