This measure abstraction paper tool is provided as an optional, informal mechanism to aid inpatient psychiatric facilities in the collection of the HBIPS-5 measure for the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program. The tool is designed to collect patient-specific data and starting the summer of 2023, IPFs will be required to submit patient-level data to the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) Secure Portal. Once data are submitted, they will be stored in the CMS Centralized Data Repository for data analysis and report generation.
