Preview data will be available to participating inpatient facilities **May 17–June 15, 2022** via the QualityNet Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) page: <https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login>

Access Preview Data

1. Navigate to the HQR page: <https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login>
2. Enter your Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) User ID and Password. Then, select **Login**.
3. You will see the **Two-Factor Authorization page**. Select **Text** or **Email**. Select **Continue**.
4. Enter the code you received and select **Continue**.
5. Read the Terms and Conditions statement. Select **Accept** to proceed. You will see the **HQR landing page**. Note: If Cancel is selected, the program closes.
6. On the **HQR landing page**, hover over the Lock Menu on the left side.
7. Select **Program Reporting**.
8. From the drop-down menu, select **Public Reporting**.
9. The page will refresh, and the preview data will be available.

Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) Survey

- Results reflect Q4 2020–Q3 2021 discharges.
- You can preview individual questions from the HCAHPS composite measures in the downloadable database in the Provider Data Catalog ([PDC](#)); they are not displayed on Care Compare.
- HCAHPS scores based on fewer than 25 completed surveys will display on the Preview with Footnote 1. Scores will not be reported on Care Compare.

Timely and Effective Care Measures

- Influenza Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) displays 2020–2021 flu season data (Q4 2020–Q1 2021).
- SEP-1 and PC-01 measure results include Q4 2020–Q3 2021 data. (Severe Sepsis and Septic Shock 3-hour and 6-hour bundle data are in a downloadable database on [PDC](#).)

Complication and Deaths

30-Day Death Rate measure results reflect 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q2 2021.

- CMS will not report the CMS Patient Safety Indicator (PSI) measure results to hospitals, nor refresh results on Care Compare or the PDC as part of the IQR/PR July 2022 refresh.
- This release will not update MORT-30-PN.
- Healthcare-associated Infection (HAI) measure rates reflect Q4 2020–Q3 2021.
- Surgical complications rates reflect Q2 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q1 2021 discharges.

Unplanned Hospital Visits

- Condition-specific readmission rates reflect Q3 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q2 2021 discharges. This release will not update READM-30-PN.
- Procedure-specific readmission rates reflect Q3 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q2 2021 discharges.
- Hospital-wide readmission rates reflect Q3 2020 and Q2 2021 discharges.
- Excess Days in Acute Care (EDAC) measure results reflect Q3 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q2 2021 discharge data.

Payment and Value of Care

- Payment measures
 - Acute myocardial infarction (AMI), heart failure, and pneumonia payment measure results reflect Q3 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q2 2021 discharges. This release will not update PN Value of Care.
 - 90-day hip/knee payment measure results reflect Q2 2018–Q4 2019 & Q3 2020–Q1 2021 discharges.
- Medicare Spending per Beneficiary (MSPB) measure performance scores display for Q3 2020–Q4 2020 discharges.
