Ambulatory Surgical Center Quality Reporting News Blast

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As the saying goes, "Knowledge is Power!" When it comes to the successful reporting of quality data for your facility - it's good to stay *in the know*!

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Ambulatory Surgical Center Quality Reporting (ASCQR) Program released this year's <u>ASCQR Successful Reporting Guide</u>. The guide brings a wealth of knowledge right to your fingertips! We hope you will also find the attached **Operations Check Sheet** helpful in managing data submissions and deadlines.

The next submission deadline is **Monday, May 15, 2023.** Here's what to submit:

- ASC-20 (COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel) measure data on the <u>National Healthcare Safety Network</u> (NHSN) site via <u>Secure Access Management Services</u> (SAMS).
- ASC-9, ASC-11, ASC-13, and ASC-14* measure data on the <u>Hospital Quality Reporting</u> (HQR) site.

Powerful Reporting Tips:

- **Verify** your data submission status by accessing the <u>Lookup Tool</u> on the <u>Quality Reporting</u> <u>Center</u> website. Be sure to check the "last updated" date.
- Ensure an active Facility Administrator (FA) is registered with SAMS to access the NHSN. To change your ASC's FA, visit the NHSN Change NHSN Facility Administrator page.
- Assign a "member role" to an additional person so they may also submit data.
- Ensure your data counts toward a specific month when completing the ASC-20 data requirement. Select only the weeks that begin and end in the month you intend to submit. Power Boost: Select the second or the third week of the month to avoid entering data for the wrong month.
- Ensure an active Security Official (SO) is registered with the HQR site for submitting the other web-based measures, yearly.

Power Boost: Each ASC should designate at least two SOs.

Keep the circuit active! To avoid your accounts being locked out, you must login to NHSN once every 60 days and HQR once every 90 days to keep your accounts "active."
Power Boost: If you have access to more than one ASC in HQR, you need to access each facility to indicate activity. Download your quarterly COVID-19 Submission Report for each ASC to accomplish this.

Remember, failure to complete data submission by the established deadlines puts your facility at risk of a 2% reduction to your calendar year (CY) 2024 Medicare payment update.
