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Looking Ahead to the Changes for the FY 2026 SNF VBP Program

Program Background

- The SNF VBP Program awards incentive payments to SNFs to encourage SNFs to improve the quality of care they provide to patients
 - CMS applies incentive payments prospectively to all Medicare fee-for-service (FFS) Part A claims paid under the SNF Prospective Payment System (PPS) for the applicable Program year (beginning October 1)
 - The SNF VBP Program began awarding incentive payments in FY 2019
- All SNFs paid under Medicare's SNF PPS are subject to the SNF VBP Program
 - Inclusion does not require any action on the part of SNFs

Program Background

- Statute specifies that, under the SNF VBP Program, SNFs:
 - Are evaluated by their performance on quality measures
 - Are scored on both improvement and achievement
 - Receive quarterly confidential feedback reports containing information about their performance
 - Earn incentive payments based on their performance

Program Background

- To date, performance in the SNF VBP Program is based on a single measure of all-cause hospital readmissions
- CMS adopted additional quality measures in the [FY 2023](#) and [FY 2024 SNF PPS final rules](#) for future Program years
- The expanded SNF VBP Program will begin in the FY 2026 Program year
 - CMS will apply incentive payments for performance in the FY 2026 Program year beginning October 1, 2025

Overview of FY 2026 Program Year

- For the FY 2026 Program year, CMS will assess SNF performance on **four quality measures**:
 - SNF 30-Day All-Cause Readmission Measure (SNFRM)
 - Skilled Nursing Facility Healthcare-Associated Infections Requiring Hospitalization measure (SNF HAI)
 - Total Nursing Staff Turnover measure (Nursing Staff Turnover)
 - Total Nursing Hours per Resident Day measure (Total Nurse Staffing)

Overview of FY 2026 Program Year

- Similar to prior years of the SNF VBP Program, CMS will:
 - Calculate measure results during a baseline period (FY 2022) and performance period (FY 2024) for each SNF

Overview of FY 2026 Program Year

- Similar to prior years of the SNF VBP Program, CMS will:
 - Score each SNF on achievement and improvement for each quality measure
- **New** to the expanded SNF VBP Program, CMS will:
 - Calculate measure scores for each measure for each SNF (0-10 points, higher is better)
 - Combine measure scores to calculate an overall performance score for each SNF (0-100 points, higher is better)

Overview of FY 2026 Program Year

- Similar to prior years of the SNF VBP Program, CMS will:
 - Calculate an incentive payment multiplier (IPM) for each SNF based on a SNF's performance score and the overall estimated incentive payment pool
 - Apply each SNF's IPM prospectively
 - When CMS makes payments for a SNF's Medicare FFS Part A claims in FY 2026 (beginning October 1, 2025), the adjusted federal per diem rate will be multiplied by the SNF's IPM

Review the Early Look Performance Score Reports

Purpose of the Early Look Reports

- The Early Look Reports are confidential and ***intended for informational purposes only***
- The reports are intended to familiarize SNFs with the expanded FY 2026 SNF VBP Program, including:
 - The format of the official Performance Score Report that will be distributed in 2025
 - The scoring and payment methodology that will be applied

Purpose of the Early Look Reports

- The reports inform SNFs of their historical quality measure performance during FY 2021 and FY 2022
- Using this historical measure data, the reports **model** performance in the FY 2026 SNF VBP Program year
- The reports **do not** reflect official performance in the SNF VBP Program
- The reports **will not** impact incentive payments to SNFs
 - CMS will share official performance information for the FY 2026 Program year, calculated using updated measure results from FY 2022 and FY 2024, at a later date in 2025

Overview of the Early Look Reports

- The Early Look Reports contain six worksheets:
 - Introduction
 - Overview of Performance
 - Measure Results
 - Measure Scores
 - Performance Score
 - Incentive Payment Multiplier

Worksheet 1 – Introduction

- The Introduction worksheet includes:
 - A brief summary of the expanded SNF VBP Program
 - A brief summary of the Early Look Reports and their purpose
 - A Table of Contents describing the subsequent worksheets
 - Links to additional resources and the SNF VBP Program Help Desk for questions

Worksheet 2 – Overview of Performance

- The Overview of Performance worksheet highlights key results, including:
 - Inclusion in the SNF VBP Program, as determined by the measure minimum policy requirement
 - Your SNF's incentive payment multiplier
 - Your SNF's measure results and measure scores
 - Performance comparisons to SNFs nationally and in your state

 - Guidance to interpret measure results

Worksheet 5 – Performance Score

- The Performance Score worksheet summarizes your SNF's overall performance across all four quality measures
 - It includes high-level information regarding:
 - Inclusion in the SNF VBP Program, as determined by the measure minimum policy requirement
 - Each measure score's contribution to the overall performance score
 - Your SNF's performance score
 - Your SNF's national program rank

Worksheet 6 – Incentive Payment Multiplier

- The Incentive Payment Multiplier worksheet includes your SNF's modeled incentive payment multiplier
 - When CMS makes payments for a SNF's Medicare FFS Part A claims in the applicable Program year, CMS would multiply the adjusted federal per diem rate by the SNF's incentive payment multiplier

*Reminder: the Early Look Reports use historical measure data to model performance in the expanded SNF VBP Program. The reports **will not** impact incentive payments to SNFs.*

How to Access the Early Look Reports

- To access your SNF's Early Look Report in iQIES:
 - Log into iQIES at <https://iqies.cms.gov/> using a Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) user ID and password.
 - If you do not have a HARP account, you may register for a HARP ID at <https://harp.cms.gov/register/profile-info>.
 - In the **Reports** menu, select **My Reports**.
 - From the **My Reports** page, select the **MDS 3.0 Provider Preview Reports** folder.
 - Here you can see the list of reports available for download. Locate the SNF VBP Program Early Look Report (file name format: **SNFVBP_[CCN]_FY26_ELR_Apr2024.xlsx**).
 - Once located, select **More** next to the report file name and the report will be downloaded through your browser. Once downloaded, open the file to view your facility's report.
