Overview of Public Reporting of IPFQR Program Data

Section 1886(s)(4)(E) of the Social Security Act requires the Secretary of Health and Human Services to establish procedures for publicly releasing data collected under the IPFQR Program. CMS currently publicly reports data on the <u>Medicare</u> <u>Care Compare</u> and <u>Provider Data Catalog</u> websites.

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Overview of Public Reporting of IPFQR Program Data

Medicare Care Compare allows patients, caregivers, and families to enter their city, state, or zip code to find and compare information about the quality of care at facilities.



Overview of Public Reporting of IPFQR Program Data

The Provider Data Catalog provides direct access to CMS official data that are used on the Medicare Care Compare site. Data are available to providers in open, accessible, and machine-readable formats.

2. To view publicly reported data at IPFs, select **Hospitals** in the left menu. Enter information in the MY LOCATION field to locate providers near a specific address or zip code.



- 3. On the next web page, select up to three providers by clicking the Compare button.
- 4. Once selections are complete, click the Compare button to the right of the selections in the blue bar near the top of the page.



5. The next page will display the selected hospitals in a row at the top and default to the Overview tab. Click on the Psychiatric Unit Services tab to compare IPFQR Program measure results between the selected facilities.

Psychiatric unit services

The Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program provides consumers with quality of care information to make informed decisions about options for inpatient psychiatric care. To meet the IPFQR Program requirements, eligible inpatient psychiatric facilities (IPFs), which include psychiatric hospitals and psychiatric units, are required to submit to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) data on quality measures specified by CMS. If the IPF doesn't meet program requirements for that fiscal year, CMS reduces the annual update otherwise applicable to an IPF for a fiscal year by 2 percentage points. The quality data that IPFs must submit address these topics:

- Preventive care and screening
- Substance use treatment
- Patient safety
- Follow-up care
- Unplanned readmissions

These quality measures show how often or how quickly inpatient psychiatric facilities that are eligible for the IPFQR Program give recommended treatments and services known to get the best results for people with mental health conditions, substance abuse, and other health conditions. Some measures also describe whether these facilities have certain processes and procedures in place. Quality measure	What is this and why is it important?			
COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) Higher percentages are better	 CMS believes it is important to incentivize and track HCP vaccination in inpatient psychiatric facilities (IPFs) through quality measurement to protect health care workers, patients, and caregivers, and to help sustain the ability of hospitals to continue serving their communities throughout the Public Health Emergency (PHE) and beyond. The measure will assess the proportion of an IPF's health care workforce that is vaccinated against COVID-19. This quarterly measure identifies the percent of healthcare personnel who completed COVID-19 primary vaccination series. 			

Which patients are included

Measures in the IPFQR Program apply to all patients treated in a psychiatric hospital or psychiatric unit. This includes Medicare beneficiaries enrolled in Original Medicare (traditional fee-for-service Medicare) and non-Medicare patients. The measures that CMS calculates using Medicare claims (which includes several measures of follow-up care) include only patients enrolled in Original Medicare.

Where the information comes from

- Data for most measures reported for IPFs come from patient medical records. IPFs calculate results and submit the facility-level data for eligible patients to CMS through a web-based form. When submitting the data, IPFs must acknowledge that all of the information submitted is complete and accurate to the best of their knowledge.
- CMS calculates some measures of follow-up care using both Medicare claims and other data. Using
 claims and other data makes it possible to calculate rates of unplanned hospital visits after discharge
 (readmissions) and follow-up care from an outpatient mental health provider after discharge, without
 having to review medical charts or requiring IPFs to report additional information.

Risk adjustment

To accurately compare IPF performance, the unplanned readmission measure adjusts for patient characteristics that may make readmission more likely. These characteristics include the patient's age, past medical history, and other diseases or conditions the patient had when they were admitted that are known to increase the patient's chance of returning to the IPF.

Significance testing

The statistical model used to calculate the unplanned readmission after leaving the IPF provides interval estimates for each IPF's results. The upper and lower boundaries of an interval estimate represents a range in which there is 95% certainty of where the true results lie.

IPF performance categories

The measure evaluating unplanned readmission after leaving the IPF assigns IPF results to performance categories. To assign readmission performance categories, the IPF's interval estimate is compared to the national rate of readmissions. The table below describes the performance categories and classification criteria in detail:

Category	Better than the national rate	No different than the national rate	Worse than the national rate	The number of cases is too small
Criterion	The entire 95% interval estimate surrounding the hospital's rate is lower than the national rate.	The 95% interval estimate surrounding the hospital's rate includes the national rate.	The entire 95% interval estimate surrounding the hospital's rate is higher than the national rate.	Fewer than 25 cases

View Facility-Level IPFQR Program Data

Listed below are instructions to view the numerator, denominator, and rate or percentage values of a measure(s) reported to the IPFQR Program by a specific IPF by CMS Certification Number (CCN). The following instructions describe ways to review the data set in Microsoft Excel by facility; however, these instructions are also applicable for the state- and national-level data tables.

- Follow instructions listed above to download the dataset as a CSV or CSV for Excel file.
- Open the file from Microsoft Excel. At this point, you may choose to save the file as a Microsoft Excel file using the naming convention of your choice.
- 3. Add filters to columns.
 - a) Select columns all the way across from column A through the last column of data that you wish to review.
 - b) Click the Sort & Filter button in the top Home menu.
 - c) Select Filter.
- 4. View data for one or more specific IPFs, preserving all original data in the file.
 - a) Click on the filter down arrow for Column A. A list of all CCNs will appear.
 - b) Deselect the checkbox next to Select All.
 - c) Click on the checkbox next to the CCN(s) of the IPF(s) you wish to view.
 - d) Click OK and only data for the selected CCN(s) will appear. To view all data for all CCNs, go back to the filter for Column A and select the checkbox next to Select All.
- 5. View data for one or more specific IPFs, removing data for other facilities from the file.
 - a) Right-click on the tab of the original data file.
 - b) Select Move or Copy.
 - c) Click on the checkbox next to Create a Copy and click OK.
 - d) Click on the filter down arrow for Column A in the copy version of the spreadsheet. A list of all CCNs will appear.
 - e) Deselect the checkbox next to the CCN(s) of the IPF(s) you wish to keep
 f) Click OK.
 - g) Highlight from Row 2 down to the last CCN listed in the file.
 - h) Right click and select Delete Row.
 - i) Click on the filter for Column and select the checkbox next to Select All to review the data for the remaining IPF(s) selected in step 5e.
- 6. View data for only one measure for providers in State X.
 - a) Click on the filter in column E.
 - b) Deselect State X.
 - c) Highlight rows 2 through last row of data.
 - d) Right click and select Delete Row.
 - e) Click on the filter in column E.
 - f) Select State X.

 - The public reporting websites are usually refreshed on a quarterly basis, as is reflected in the naming convention of the zip files: hospitals_MM_YYYY
 - The most current zip file for a given year is at the top of the list.
 - Each zip file contains CSV files for all data reported to CMS.
