




**Example of Two Browsers/Tabs Open in Same Event**

## **Changes and Updates to the 2020 CMS QRDA Category I IG for HQR**

### **Background**

- CMS has published the 2020 CMS QRDA Category I IG Version 1.1, <u>Schematron</u>, and <u>Sample File for HQR (IG Updated December 3,</u> 2019; schematron and sample file updated March 2020).
- The 2020 CMS QRDA I IG outlines requirements for eligible hospitals and critical access hospitals to report electronic clinical quality measures (eCQMs) for the CY 2020 reporting period for the following programs:
  - Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting (IQR) Program
  - Medicare and Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program for Eligible Hospitals and Critical Access Hospitals (CAHs)
- The 2020 CMS QRDA I Schematron is a companion to the 2020 CMS QRDA I IG and allows for computerized validation of QRDA documents against the IG requirements.

## 2020 IG Updates: Key Elements for Succession Management

No changes to the five key elements used for succession management from the 2019 IG:

- CMS Certification Number (CCN)
- CMS Program Name
- EHR Patient ID
- EHR Submitter ID, and
- Reporting period specified in the Reporting Parameters Section

## **2020 IG Updates:** Patient Identifiers

No changes to the patient identifier requirements from the 2019 IG:

- Patient Identification Number is required
- Medicare Beneficiary Identifier (MBI) is not required, but should be submitted if the payer is Medicare and the patient has an MBI number assigned
- Medicare Health Insurance Claim (HIC) Number is not required, but should be submitted if the payer is Medicare and the patient has an HICN assigned

Patient identifiers are specified in ClinicalDocument/recordTarget.

 The error description was updated to validate that each measure must reference the eCQM Version Specific Measure Identifier and that only the eCQM Specifications for EHs/CAHs for 2020 reporting period will be accepted.

## 2020 IG Updates: "Not Done" with a Reason

- The section is updated for clarity.
  - Must set the attribute negataionInd="true"
  - If QDM element in eCQM specification is defined using a value set
    - Must provide code/[@nullFlavor="NA"]
    - Must provide the value set OID instead of a specific code from the value set.
    - Set the code attribute code/sdtc:valueset="[VSAC value set OID]"
  - If QDM element in eCQM specification is defined using direct referenced code:
    - Must provide code/[@nullFlavor="NA"]
    - Must provide the direct referenced code.
    - Set the code attribute code ="[The Direct Referenced Code]"
  - Must provide the reason for negation

## 2020 IG Updates: Reason Template Placement

- New appendix Reason Template Placement When Specifying "Not Done" with a Reason
  - Reason (V3) template is nested directly within the element containing the negationInd attribute
  - Examples provided for
    - Device, Not Applied
    - Device, Not Ordered
    - Medication, Not Administered
    - Medication, Not Discharged
    - Medication, Not Ordered

## 2020 IG Updates: Ensuring Data Uniqueness

- New appendix Ensuring Data Uniqueness
  - Duplicated data could potentially lead to increased data processing time, but most importantly, might cause incorrect processing and therefore produce unexpected measure results when calculated by other entities.
  - Each reported QDM data element contains all of the attributes (e.g., discharge status, facility location, etc.) required by all measures, which are reported in the file, in the same QRDA template for the same instance.
  - Not to duplicate QDM data element by including sdtc:valueSet
  - Key data elements for determining each unique episode of care
    - Encounter id element
    - Encounter code
    - Admission date time
    - Discharge date time
