


# **Troubleshooting Echo**




# HBIPS-2 and HBIPS-3 Measure Results: Mean Values




# HBIPS-2 and HBIPS-3 Measure Results: Median Values





# HBIPS-5 and Screening for Metabolic Disorder Measure Results




#### SUB-2/-2a, SUB-3/-3a Measure Results


## TOB-2/-2a, TOB-3/-3a Measure Results






# **COVID HCP Personnel Measure**


COVID HCP=COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel

#### FUH 7-Day and 30-Day Measure Results





#### Goodbye, retired measures

- IPFs collected Timely Transmission of Transition Record measure data for the last time in CY 2021.
- CY 2021 was also the last year that CMS calculated rates for the Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness measure.

# **COVID HCP Measure**

IPFs will continue to collect and report data for the COVID HCP measure on a monthly basis to meet requirements for the FY 2024 payment determination.

# Follow-Up After Psychiatric Hospitalization Measure

CMS will calculate the claims-based Follow-Up After Psychiatric Hospitalization (FAPH) measure for the FY 2024 payment determination onward.

- The FAPH measure is an expanded and enhanced version of the Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH) measure that addresses the percentage of Medicare fee for service (FFS) beneficiaries who were discharged from an IPF with a principal diagnosis of select mental illness or substance use disorders (SUDs) for which the patient received a followup visit for treatment of mental illness or SUD.
- FAPH is a claims-based measure and does not require chart-abstraction nor data entry on the part of the IPFs nor their vendors.
