



Click Refresh or press F5.





Example of Two Browsers/Tabs Open in Same Event







Release Notes

The Release Notes outline the information that was added, changed, and removed from the previous version. The Release Notes document is available for download in the **Complete Manual** table.

Version 1.0b - Effective for Discharges starting 01/01/2022

The Specifications Manual for National Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Measures (IPF Specifications Manual) contains abstraction guidance and technical specifications to successfully submit the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) inpatient psychiatric facilities quality measures.

Over time, it will be necessary to present more than one version of the manual on this web page so that a specific data collection time period (i.e., based on effective discharge date) can be associated with the applicable manual.

The Release Notes for each version of the manual outline the changes associated with that specific release and include corrections and clarifications based on ongoing alignment discussions between the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and the Joint Commission.

Guidelines for Using Release Notes

Release Notes Version 1.0b provides a high-level overview of changes to the Specifications Manual for National Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Measures (IPF Specifications Manual). This Release Notes document is to be used as a reference and is not intended to be used to develop abstraction tools. Please refer to the IPF Specifications Manual for references to the complete and current technical specification and abstraction information.

These notes are organized to follow the Table of Contents in the *IPF Specifications Manual*. The headings are described below:

- Impacts used to identify the impacted measures and portion(s) of the Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting Program Manual section (e.g., Measure Specifications, Appendix).
- Rationale provided for the change being made.
- Description of Changes used to identify the section within the document where the change occurs (e.g., Definition, Data Collection Question, Allowable Values, and Denominator Statement).

Note: Additions are called out specifically in the Release Notes and yellow highlighted in the corresponding document. The changes in the IPF Clinical Data and IPF Facility Level XML File Layouts have yellow highlighted cells with actual changes noted in **bold**.

Major Changes, v1.0b



Purpose and Dates

The IPF Specifications Manual is intended for use as a reference to facilitate successful PLR of measure data and facility-level data reporting to CMS for the IPFQR Program.

- Effective date: January 1, 2022
- Reporting Period: Calendar year (CY) 2022 discharges for all measure and non-measure data* and quarterly reporting of COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Health Care Personnel (COVID HCP)
- Submission Period: Summer 2023, except COVID HCP
- Payment Determination: Impacting FY 2024 Annual Payment Update
- **Composition:** One main document and two XML file layouts pertinent to PLR of measure data and facility-level reporting of the HBIPS-2 and HBIPS-3 denominator value and non-measure data.

^{*}Except Influenza Immunization (IMM-2) (October 1, 2022–March 31, 2023)



Section 1: Data Dictionary

In Section 1, and throughout the manual, references to the Timely Transmission of Transition Record (TR-2) measure and its data elements were removed.

Additionally, the following data elements were added to account for collection of discharge data by payer for the non-measure data in the IPF Facility-Level XML file:

- Payer Medicare
- Payer Non-Medicare



Section 2: Measurement Information

Information about how CMS will publicly report the Screening for Metabolic Disorders (SMD) measure was updated.

Data Reported As: Aggregate rate generated from count (i.e., patient-level) data reported as a proportion at facility, state, and national levels.



Section 4: Population and Sampling Specifications

References to TR-2 were removed from this section.



Section 5: Data Transmission

Throughout Section 5, the IPF Facility-Level Data XML file layout replaces the Non-Measure Data XML file layout and includes data elements for the reporting of both non-measure data and the denominator value for the Hospital-Based Inpatient Psychiatric Services (HBIPS)-2 and HBIPS-3 measures.



Section 5: Data Transmission

Additionally, this section includes details regarding IPF unit specific CMS Certification Numbers (CCNs) in the Provider section of the XML files.

- CMS Certification Number IPF's six-digit CCN, which is required by CMS.
 The CMS Certification Number (CCN) must be a valid, numeric, 6-digit number.
 IPF units that are part of a larger hospital must replace the letter(s) in the IPF unit specific CCN as follows:
 - Change "S" to "0"
 - Change "M" with "1"
 - Change "SA" with "20"

Free standing IPF CCNs are numeric; therefore, no changes are needed.

Updates to the IPF Clinical Data and the IPF Facility-Level XML File Layouts pertain to the IPF unit specific CCNs and removal of TR-2 measure data elements.



Section 6: CMS Outcome Measures (Claims Based)

Reference to the Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH) measure was removed from this section.

Purpose and Dates

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Section 2: Measurement Information

CMS approved updating verbiage pertaining to the identification of the Initial Patient Population for the Screening for Metabolic Disorders measure for clarification and to reduce burden during the abstraction process.

Screening for Metabolic Disorders (SMD) Initial Patient Population

The initial patient population is all patients discharged from an IPF during the measurement period. Refer to the measure algorithm and narrative for details.



Section 4: Population and Sampling Specifications

Specifications for the identification of the Initial Patient Population for the Screening for Metabolic Disorders measure was also updated in Section 4 of the manual.
