Purpose and Key Questions for Modules

Usefulness of Reporting Cumulative Vaccine Coverage in NHSN

- Provide consistent and comparable data for facilities
 - Vaccination coverage may change as new staff are hired
 - Help target facility-level tracking and improvement efforts
- Deliver data to health authorities
 - Help identify vaccination coverage gaps and vaccine supply issues
 - Improve infection control policies and recommendations

Five Key Questions for Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Modules

- 2. * Number of these HCP who have ever been vaccinated (cumulative number vaccinated) with a COVID-19 vaccine?





Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Reporting for Healthcare Personnel (HCP)



Key Updates: September 2021

- Revised HCP categories on the data collection form
 - Employee HCP
 - Non-employee HCP
 - Licensed independent practitioners
 - Adult students/trainees and volunteers
 - Other contract personnel
- All staff categories are required
- Facilities need to create a monthly reporting plan before entering data into the Healthcare Personnel Safety (HPS) Component in NHSN
- Question #3.2 (offered but declined COVID-19 vaccine) and question #3.3 (unknown COVID-19 vaccination status) are required
- All individuals reported in question 1 must be accounted for in question 2 or question 3


The monthly reporting plan indicates to the NHSN system which modules and protocols a user intends to follow for surveillance purposes in a specific month. The plan must be completed before data are entered for that month. Monthly reporting plans must be created or updated to include resident and HCP COVID-19 vaccination summary reporting, i.e., vaccination data must be "in-plan" for data to be shared with CMS.

Question #1: *Cumulative number of HCP eligible to have worked at the facility

- Include all HCP who were eligible to have worked at this facility for at least 1 day during the week of data collection
 - Working any part of a day is considered as working 1 day
 - Include HCP even if they are on temporary leave during the week of data collection. Temporary leave is defined as less than or equal to 2 weeks in duration
 - Examples of temporary leave may include sick leave or vacation
 - If temporary leave extends past 2 weeks, then the healthcare worker should not be included in question #1 for the current week of data collection
- Data must be entered for each of the healthcare personnel categories
- Each individual should be counted only once in question 1


Question #1: *Cumulative number of HCP eligible to have worked at the facility

- Totals for 'All Core HCP' and 'All HCP' will be autocalculated by NHSN
 - All Core HCP 🔯
 - The sum of employees, licensed independent practitioners, and adult students/trainees & volunteers
 - All HCP☆
 - The sum of employees, licensed independent practitioners, adult students/trainees & volunteers, and other contract personnel



Healthcare Personnel Categories – Employee HCP

- Employees (staff on payroll) [required]☆
 - Include all persons receiving a direct paycheck from the healthcare facility (i.e., on the facility's payroll), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.




Healthcare Personnel Categories – Non-Employee HCP

- Licensed independent practitioners (Physicians, advanced practice nurses, & physician assistants) [required]
 - Include physicians (MD, DO); advanced practice nurses; and physician assistants only who are affiliated with the healthcare facility, but are not directly employed by it (i.e., they do not receive a paycheck from the facility), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact. Postresidency fellows are also included in this category.




Healthcare Personnel Categories - Non-Employee HCP

- Adult students / trainees & volunteers [required] *
 - Include medical, nursing, or other health professional students, interns, medical residents, or volunteers aged 18 or older who are affiliated with the healthcare facility, but are not directly employed by it (i.e., they do not receive a paycheck from the facility), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.



Healthcare Personnel Categories – Non-Employee HCP


- Other Contract Personnel [required]
 - Defined as persons providing care, treatment, or services at the facility through a contract who do not meet the definition of any other required personnel category.
 - This includes agency and/or pro re nata (PRN) staff who are scheduled to work at the facility at least once per week.




Each week, report all HCP in Question #1 who have <u>ever</u> received vaccine

- Example:
 - Week 1: 10 individuals received dose 1 of COVID-19 vaccine
 - Week 2: 5 more individuals received dose 1 of COVID-19 vaccine
 - For Week 1: Report <u>10</u> individuals received dose 1 of COVID-19 vaccine
 - For Week 2: Report <u>15</u> individuals received dose 1 of COVID-19 vaccine

- Step 1: Select a COVID-19 vaccine from the drop-down box
 - Pfizer-BioNTech
 - Moderna
 - Janssen
 - Unspecified manufacturer




- Step 2: Enter cumulative number of current HCP who received only dose 1 of a vaccine series
- Step 3: Enter cumulative number of current HCP who received both dose 1 and dose 2 of a vaccine series
- Step 4: If HCP received another type of vaccine, repeat steps 1-3



- Include receipt of COVID-19 vaccine at the facility, or elsewhere
 - If documentation is not provided, report HCP in question #3.3 (unknown COVID-19 vaccination status)
- NHSN automatically calculates number of individuals who have completed vaccination.

- Vaccination data collected:
 - Last month, 20 individuals received dose 1 of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine
 - This week, 2 of these 20 individuals received dose 2 of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine
- NHSN reporting for this week:
 - 18 HCP would still be reported as receiving <u>only</u> dose 1 of a series of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine
 - 2 HCP who have now received dose 2 of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine would be reported as receiving dose 1 and dose 2 of a series



Question #3.1:*Cumulative number of HCP in Question #1 who have medical contraindications to COVID-19 vaccine


- CDC "Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines Currently Approved or Authorized in the United States" provides information on medical contraindications
 - cdc.gov/vaccines/covid-19/info-by-product/clinicalconsiderations.html
 - Include HCP who have not received any COVID-19 vaccine due to one of the following medical contraindications:
 - Severe allergic reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) after a previous dose or to a component of the COVID-19 vaccine
 - Known diagnosed allergy to a component of the COVID-19 vaccine

Question #3.2 & 3.3: *Cumulative number of individuals in Question #1 who declined vaccine (3.2) & have unknown vaccine status (3.3)

- Philosophical, religious, or other reasons for declining COVID-19 vaccine not listed in the <u>Interim Clinical</u> <u>Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines Currently</u> <u>Authorized in the United States</u> are **not** considered medical contraindications for COVID-19 vaccination (should be reported under Question 3.2)
- Use "Unknown COVID-19 vaccination status" for reporting individuals without documentation of vaccination
- Questions 3.1 3.3 are required ★

Question #2 & Question #3

- All HCP included in question 1 must be accounted for in question 2 or question 3 *
- This means that the sum of values entered for question 2 (2.1 2.99) and question 3 (3.1 3.3) must equal the total number of individuals entered in question 1 ★



Question #4: *Cumulative number of HCP in question #2 eligible to receive an additional dose or booster of COVID-19 vaccine

- Fully vaccinated: having completed an initial vaccine series
- Additional dose or booster: COVID-19 vaccine received ≥2 weeks after completion of an initial vaccine series
 - Additional dose refers to an additional dose of vaccine administered when the immune response following an initial completed vaccine series is likely to be insufficient
 - Booster dose refers to an additional dose of vaccine administered when the initial sufficient immune response to an initial completed vaccine series is likely to have waned over time
- Please refer to the <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines | CDC</u> to determine individuals who are eligible to receive an additional dose or booster after receiving a complete vaccine series

How should facilities determine who is considered eligible for an additional dose or booster dose at this time?

Facilities should refer to the CDC's Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines Currently Approved or Authorized in the United States to determine individuals who are eligible to receive additional doses or boosters after receiving an initial completed vaccination series. As of November 2021, individuals eligible to receive an additional or booster dose include the following:

Category	Primary Vaccine Series	Time Since Primary Vaccine Series Completion	Eligible for
Moderately and severely immunocompromised people	mRNA	≥2 weeks	Additional dose
Persons aged ≥18 years who received a Janssen primary series	Janssen	≥2 months	Booster dose
Persons aged ≥ 18 years	mRNA	≥6 months	Booster dose

Question #5: *Cumulative number of HCP in question #4 who have received an additional dose or booster of COVID-19 vaccine at this facility or elsewhere since August 2021

- Each week, report <u>all</u> HCP in question 4 (who are eligible to have received an additional dose or booster) who have ever received an additional dose or booster since August 2021
- Include receipt of additional dose or booster at the facility or elsewhere
- Example:
 - Week 1: 5 HCP received an additional dose or booster of a COVID-19 vaccine
 - Week 2: 3 more HCP received an additional or booster of a COVID-19 vaccine
 - For Week 1: Report <u>5</u> HCP received an additional dose or booster
 - For Week 2: Report **8** HCP received an additional dose or booster

Question #5: *Cumulative number of HCP in question #4 who have received an additional dose or booster of COVID-19 vaccine at this facility or elsewhere since August 2021

- Step 1: Select a COVID-19 vaccine from the drop-down box
 - Pfizer-BioNTech
 - Moderna
 - Janssen
 - Unspecified manufacturer
- Step 2: Enter cumulative number of HCP who received An additional dose or booster

PFIZBION3 - Additional dose or booster of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine

MODERNA3 - Additional dose or booster of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine



Question #5: *Cumulative number of HCP in question #4 who have received an additional dose or booster of COVID-19 vaccine at this facility or elsewhere since August 2021

• **Step 3**: If HCP received an additional dose or booster of another type of vaccine, repeat steps 1-2

NHSN automatically calculates total number of HCP who received an additional dose or booster.



Question #5

- If a facility does not have any individuals who received an additional dose or booster of COVID-19 vaccine
 - Select any manufacturer from the dropdown
 - Enter zero ("0") for question #5
- Only individuals who have <u>received</u> an additional dose or booster should be reported in question 5

Question #6: *Describe the availability of COVID-19 vaccine(s)

- Question 6.1: Is your facility a vaccine provider? [Yes/No]
 - Only facilities enrolled as vaccine providers can legally store, handle, and administer COVID-19 vaccine in the United States.
 - How to Enroll as a COVID-19 Vaccination Provider | CDC

- Question 6.2: If a vaccine provider, is vaccine supply sufficient this week?
- Question 6.3: If not a vaccine provider, are other arrangements sufficient?
- Question 6.4: Free text description of vaccine supply issues (optional)

Reminder: Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS)

- Adverse events should be reported to VAERS: vaers.hhs.gov/reportevent.html
- To help identify reports from NHSN sites, please enter your NHSN orgID in Box 26 of the VAERS form
- Report clinically significant COVID-19 vaccine adverse events
 - Serious adverse events (such as death, life-threatening conditions, or inpatient hospitalization) that occur after vaccination, even if it is not certain that vaccination caused the event
 - Vaccine administration errors
 - Other clinically significant adverse events may be described in fact sheets for provider emergency use authorization or prescribing information

COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among HCP Measure and Key Resources

COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among HCP – National Quality Forum (NQF) Measure & Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Requirements

- COVID-19 vaccination coverage among HCP is an NHSN measure for NQF endorsement: <u>COVID-19 Vaccination of</u> <u>Healthcare Personnel Measure Specifications (cdc.gov)</u>
- The measure is defined as the percentage of HCP who received a complete COVID-19 vaccination series
 - Individuals having received a complete initial vaccine series (2 doses of mRNA or 1 dose of Janssen) are considered fully vaccinated.
 - Additional dose and booster dose data are required and help to inform public health response.
- The measure refers to data submitted for employees, licensed independent practitioners, and adult students/trainees & volunteers. These categories are displayed as 'All Core HCP' on the data collection form.

Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among HCP Measure Requirements

- As of October 1, 2021, facilities that are eligible to participate in the Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities Quality Reporting Program must submit COVID-19 vaccination data via the Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Module for at least one week per month to fulfill CMS reporting requirements.
- Facilities can select any week within the month to report data. Facilities
 may choose to report these data weekly. COVID-19 vaccination data
 should be submitted by the end of the quarter as defined by CMS.
- Resources pertinent to reporting this measure include:
 - <u>FY 2022 IPF PPS Final Rule</u> provides information about CMS reporting requirements for the IPFQR Program
 - QualityNet IPFQR Measures Resources includes links to the CMS IPFQR
 Program Measures and Non-Measures Data tools which list the quarterly reporting
 and submission periods for the COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among HCP
 measure

How do I get started in NHSN?

Key Roles in NHSN

Facility Administrator

- The person enrolling the facility in NHSN
- Only person who can activate additional components for a facility
- Has add/edit/delete data, users, and users' access
- Has authority to nominate/join groups for data sharing
- Only person who can re-assign the role of Facility Administrator to another user
- There is only one Facility Administrator per facility

Users

- Rights are determined by Facility Administrator: view data, data entry, and data analysis
- May be given administrative rights

Getting Started in NHSN

- Enrolling in NHSN
 - Facilities that are currently not participating in NHSN and wish to participate must <u>enroll</u> their facility in NHSN
 - Please visit http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/enrollment/index.html for more information regarding the enrollment process
 - During the enrollment process, facilities may choose to participate in any of the NHSN components
- Activating the HPS Component
 - Facilities that are <u>already enrolled</u> in NHSN and wish to participate in the HPS Component must <u>activate</u> the component within NHSN





IPF units whose CCNs differ from that of the main hospital – for example, having an "M" or "S" in the third position – must either be mapped as locations of the parent facility or enrolled as a separate NHSN facility, and their data must be reported separately. If the IPF unit CCN is 100% identical to the CCN of the parent facility, then separate HCP COVID-19 vaccination summary data reporting is not required by CMS.

Activating the HPS Component

- Facility Administrator logs into SAMS: https://nhsn2.cdc.gov/nhsn/
 - Click "NHSN Reporting"
- From the Home Page, click "Facility" then "Add/Edit Component"
 - Check box next to Healthcare Personnel Safety



- as a user within the NHSN facility
 - Click "Users" on the navigation bar, then click "Add"
 - Complete "Add User" screen mandatory fields


- NHSN Facility Administrator should transfer role to another user <u>prior</u> to leaving the facility!
- NHSN can add an individual as the new NHSN Facility Administrator if the previous NHSN Facility Administrator has left the facility
 - Do <u>not</u> re-enroll the facility in NHSN
- Complete NHSN Facility Administrator Change Request form online

- After being assigned as the new NHSN Facility Administrator, begin the new NHSN user onboarding process






Healthcare Personnel Safety Monthly Reporting Plan Form

- Collects data on which modules and months the facility plans to participate
- Facilities must complete the monthly reporting plan before entering data for that month
- Users should select from "Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Module"
- Level 3 SAMS access is needed to enter a monthly reporting plan














