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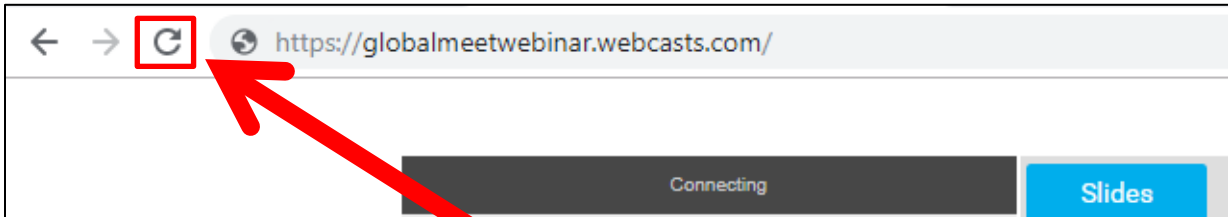


Troubleshooting Audio

Press F5



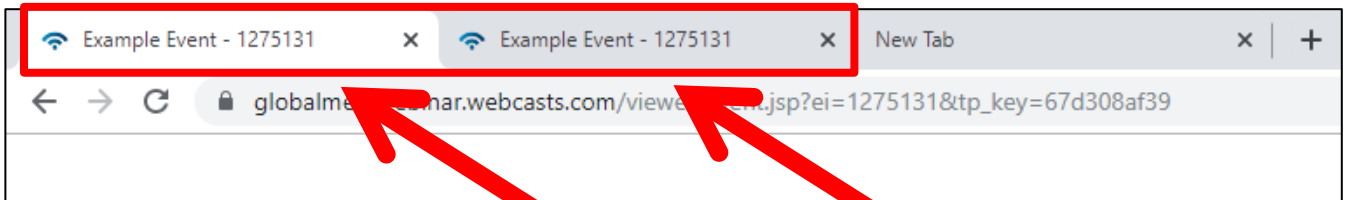

Troubleshooting Echo

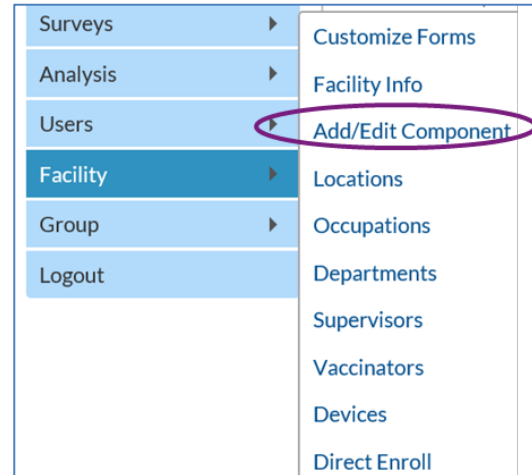
How to Get Started in NHSN

Getting Started in NHSN

- Enrolling in NHSN
 - Facilities that are currently not participating in NHSN and wish to participate must enroll their facility in NHSN. Please visit <http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/enrollment/index.html> for more information regarding the enrollment process.
 - During the enrollment process, facilities may choose to participate in any of the NHSN components.
- Activating the Healthcare Personnel Safety (HPS) Component
 - Facilities that are already enrolled in NHSN and wish to participate in the HPS Component must activate the component within NHSN.

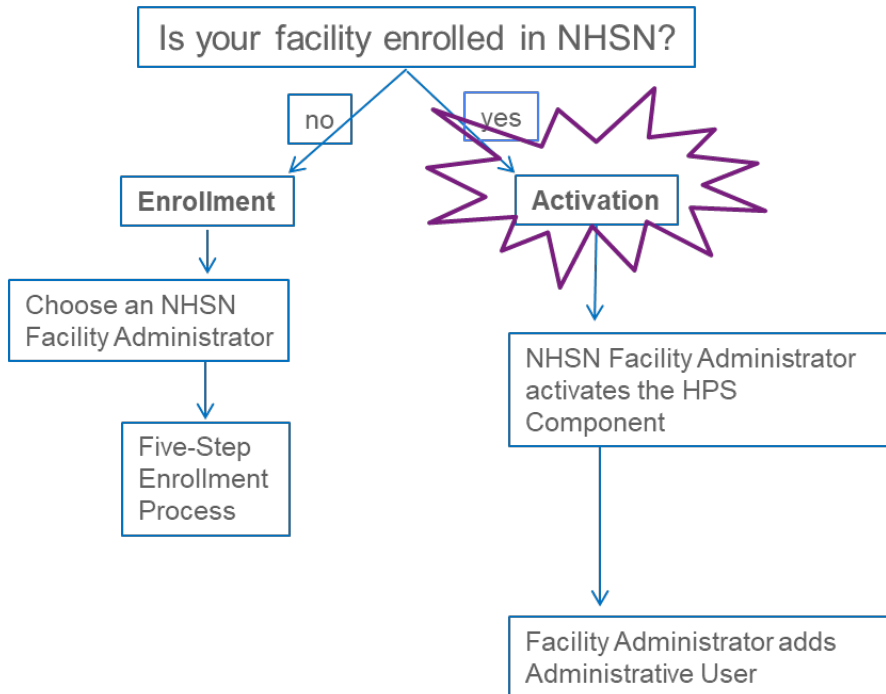
Activating HPS Component

- Facility Administrator (FA) logs into SAMS (<https://nhsn2.cdc.gov/nhsn/>) and clicks NHSN Reporting.
- From the home page, click Facility then Add/Edit Component. Then, check the box next to Healthcare Personnel Safety.
- FA adds HPS Component Primary Contact as a user within the NHSN facility.
- Click Users on the navigation bar. Click Add.
- Complete the Add User screen mandatory fields: User ID (created by the facility), First Name, Last Name, and E-mail Address (The email must be an active/correct address for the user.)
- The FA or new HPS Component Primary Contact adds other users.

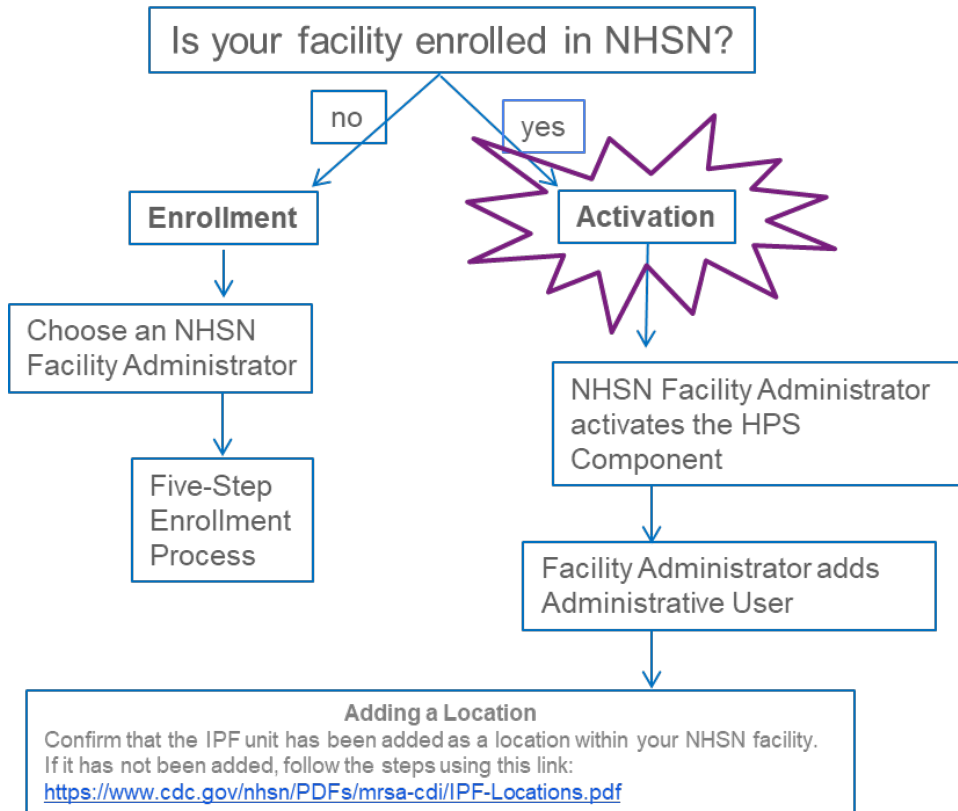


Getting Started in the HPS Component: Freestanding IPFs

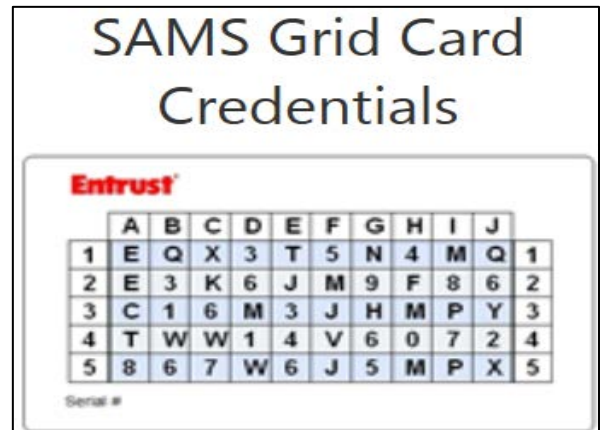

New Users to NHSN

- If you are a new user, you will need to register with Secure Access Management Services (SAMS).
- Access NHSN using SAMS credentials.
- Information on the new SAMS process is found here: [About SAMS | NHSN | CDC](#)
- Log in to NHSN at least once per year to maintain active SAMS credentials.



Change in NHSN FA

- The NHSN FA should transfer role to another user prior to leaving the facility!
- NHSN can add an individual as the new NHSN FA if the previous NHSN FA has left the facility.
 - Do not re-enroll the facility in NHSN.

- The new NHSN FA can begin the new NHSN user onboarding process.

How to Report Cumulative Data

Cumulative versus Incident Vaccination Types

- Cumulative vaccination data are the total number of individuals eligible to work in the facility for a given reporting week who have ever received the COVID-19 vaccine since it became available.
- Incident vaccination data are the number of new individuals who received COVID-19 vaccine in a specific week.

Incident data are not used for reporting COVID-19 vaccination data in NHSN!

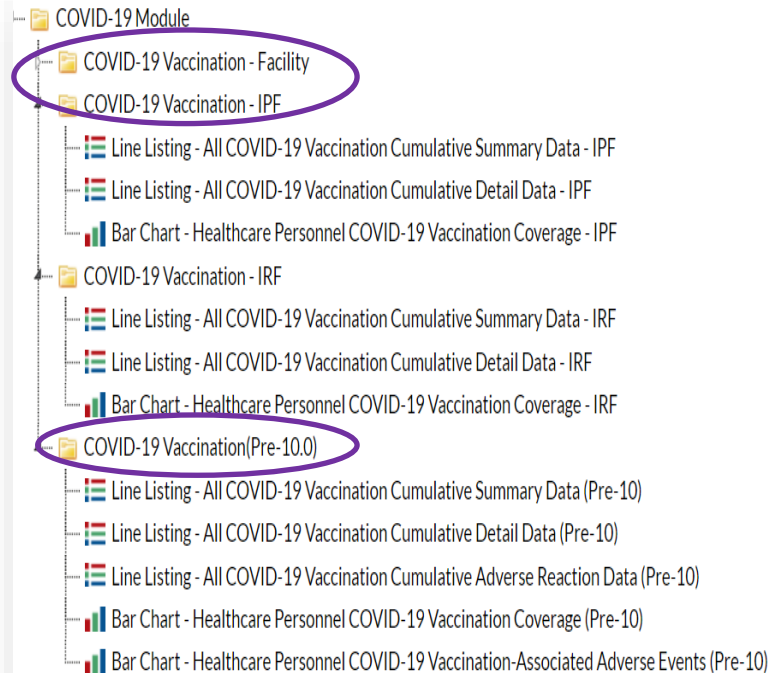

How to Leverage Report Options

NHSN Analysis and Reporting

- Users can utilize the Analysis tool within NHSN to generate summary reports for facility data.
- Reports are organized in two folders:
 - “COVID-19 Vaccination” for data after September 2021 NHSN update
 - “COVID-19 Vaccination (Pre-10.0)” for data before September 2021 NHSN update

Frequently Asked Questions

Question 1

Vendors or sales representatives come into my facility or unit and may be present during patient care activities. Should we count these vendors in the other contract personnel category?

Yes, vendors providing care, treatment, or services should be included in the other contract personnel category if they work in the facility on a regular (weekly) basis, regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.

Notes on Other Contract Personnel and Vendors

- If a facility is unable to obtain vaccination status of vendors, the individuals can be marked as an “unknown” status.
- Even though reporting of other contract personnel category is required for NHSN surveillance, it is not part of the COVID-19 HCP measure data sent to CMS for the IPFQR Program.

Question 2

Are IPFs required to report data through the COVID-19 Vaccination Module weekly or once a month?

NHSN allows for and encourages weekly submission of COVID-19 vaccination data via the Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Module. Facilities that are part of the IPFQR Program must submit COVID-19 vaccination data via the Weekly COVID-19 Vaccination Module for at least one week per month to fulfill CMS reporting requirements. Facilities can select any week within the month to report data. Facilities may choose to report these data weekly. COVID-19 vaccination data should be submitted by the end of the quarter as defined by CMS. A week is designated as belonging to the month of the weekend date. For example, reporting data for the week of September 27 through October 3 is considered submitting data for a week in October.

Question 3

My IPF unit has a distinct CCN, with an "S" in the 3rd position. It's part of a larger (acute care) hospital. Why do I need to map the location of the IPF when it is in a building that is separate from the main hospital?

Mapping the location of the IPF unit – even those that are not physically located within the main hospital – is necessary to ensure data submitted by the distinct IPF unit are received by CMS to meet IPFQR Program reporting requirements pertaining to the annual payment update and to ensure accurate public reporting of the COVID-19 HCP measure data for the IPF unit. Once the IPF unit is added as a location of the parent hospital, the IPF unit-specific CCN is linked with that location. IPF units that have a distinct CCN from the parent hospital do not need to enroll or activate the HPS Component separately, unless their parent hospital is not already enrolled in NHSN. Question 4

If my IPF unit has the exact same CCN as my acute care, long-term care, children's, cancer, or critical access facility, do I need to report the IPF unit data separately from this facility?

No. If the IPF unit CCN is 100% identical to the CCN of the parent facility, then separate HCP COVID-19 vaccination summary data reporting is not required by CMS. Therefore, counts of HCP working in the IPF unit can be included in the total counts for the parent facility. However, IPF units that have an "M" or "S" in the third position must either be mapped as locations of the parent facility or enrolled as a separate NHSN facility, and their data must be reported separately.

Question 5

Can I submit COVID-19 vaccination data for an IPF unit in the same .CSV file as the COVID-19 vaccination data for its affiliated facility?

No. A .CSV file can only contain one OrgID per reporting week. Facilities or groups that wish to report COVID-19 vaccination data for an IPF unit via .CSV file should submit IPF unit data in a separate .CSV file from the main hospital's data.

Updates

Vaccine Data Tracking Worksheet Updates for 2022

The Vaccine Data Tracking Worksheets are updated for 2022. Links can be found on NHSN under the Data Tracking Worksheets section:

Looking ahead: NHSN will allow users to manage their person-level tracking worksheet in the application in a future release.

Removal of Eligibility Question

- In the February 2022 NHSN release, the question on individuals **eligible** for an additional dose or booster (previously Question 4) was removed.
- Reasons for the removal of this question include:
 - Simplification of reporting for users
 - Unnecessary since almost everyone is now eligible for a booster dose.

Q1 2022	Jan 1–Mar 31, 2022	August 15, 2022
Q2 2022	Apr 1–Jun 30, 2022	November 15, 2022
Q3 2022	Jul 1–Sep 30, 2022	February 15, 2023
Q4 2022	Oct 1–Dec 31, 2022	May 16, 2023
