Subject: FY 2023 IPF PPS Proposed Rule Published, Open for Public Comment

On April 4, 2022, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities Prospective Payment System (IPF PPS) Proposed Rule published in the *Federal Register* (86 FR 19480). The FY 2023 IPF PPS Proposed Rule initially went on display at the Office of the Federal Register Public Inspection Desk on April 1, 2022.

CMS will accept comments on the proposed rule until **May 31, 2022**, and will respond in a final rule that is scheduled to be issued in August 2022.

Included in the regulation are payment and policy proposals for the IPF PPS. In addition, CMS requests information on the Overarching Principles for Measuring Healthcare Quality Disparities Across CMS Quality Programs. There are no proposed changes to the Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program.
