An announcement from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS):

CART, the CMS Abstraction & Reporting Tool, is now available in the HQR System for the Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) SUB measure set.

IPFs can use this tool to abstract XML files for only the CY 2021 SUB measure set data at this time. To satisfy all IPFQR program requirements, facilities should submit all aggregate data for the <a href="IPFQR">IPFQR</a>
<a href="Program measures">Program measures</a> in the Simple Data Entry Tool of the HQR Secure Portal. After submitting all aggregate measure and non-measure data in the HQR Secure Portal, IPFs may voluntarily submit patient-level measure data to test processes for and gain experience in submitting patient-level data prior to the FY 2024 data submission period.
