Subject: Publicly available for download now: example IPF-specific reports using mock data for Fiscal Year 2023 IPFQR program claims-based measures

The Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program has provided inpatient psychiatric facilities (IPFs) with Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 IPF-Specific Reports (ISRs) for claims-based measures. The ISRs are available for download through the *Managed File Transfer (MFT) Dashboard*. Users will need to log in to the MFT Dashboard using their HARP username and password to access the mailbox.

ISRs allow IPFs to review the information that will be publicly reported for the *Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness, Medication Continuation Following Inpatient Psychiatric Discharge, and Thirty-Day All-Cause Unplanned Readmission Following Psychiatric Hospitalization in an IPF* measures, which are calculated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) using administrative claims data.

An example ISR for each measure using mock data is now available for download in a zip file along with the ISR user guide on the QualityNet [IPFQR Public Reporting](#) webpage. These example ISRs may be helpful for IPFs that did not receive an ISR because they were not open in time for FY 2023 measure calculation.
