Starting today, you have 30 days to review data from your hospital that will be publicly reported on the [Care Compare website](#) in October 2022. Medicare beneficiaries and the public use Care Compare to review quality measure data for participating hospitals and facilities.

When can I see my hospital's preview data?

Now through August 30, 2022, on the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) page on QualityNet (<https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login>), you can preview the data that will appear on the October 2022 release. We encourage you to look at your information early in this preview period to conduct a thorough review.

Note: IPF data referenced in this preview pertain to fiscal year (FY) 2022 annual payment update (APU) determination, except for the Quarter (Q)4 2021 COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel (COVID HCP) measure data, which pertains to FY 2023 APU determination.

How do I find my hospital's preview data?

Access your Public Reporting preview data by following these steps:

1. Navigate to the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) page: <https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login>
2. Enter your Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) User ID and Password. By logging in, you agree to the terms and conditions. Select **Log in**.
3. The **Two-Factor Authorization page** will appear. Select **Text** or **Email**. Select **Next**.
4. Enter the code you received. Then, select **Next**.
5. On the **HQR landing** page, hover over Lock Menu on the left side.
6. Select **Program Reporting**.
7. From the drop-down menu, select **Public Reporting**.
8. The page will refresh, and the data will be available to preview.

To export the data displayed on the user interface (UI), select **Export Data** in the measure table. The exported measure data will be in PDF format for a user-friendly printed report.
