The Patient-Reported Outcome-based Performance Measure (PRO-PM) Following an Elective Primary Total Hip Arthroplasty (THA) and/or Total Knee Arthroplasty (TKA) permission is now available in the HQR System.

To request this permission, log into HQR with your HARP ID.

- 1. Navigate to your name at the top right corner and select **My Profile**.
- 2. On your profile page, find your organization and select **View Access.**
- 3. Select Request Change in Access.
- 4. Under *Data Submissions*, navigate to 'Patient-reported outcomes performance measure' and click **Add.**
- 5. On the next screen, select the appropriate authorization parameters (Upload/Edit or View) corresponding with the Inpatient Quality Reporting (IQR) permission.
- 6. Select Apply & Close.
- 7. When you return to your permissions, scroll to the bottom of the page and select the **Review** button, followed by **Save & Close**.

While this permission is available to all users of HQR, a new authorization via the Vendor Management process is needed to allow vendors the ability to submit data on behalf of a Provider. Please refer to the 'How to Add a Vendor' video on the HQR Playlist for more information on setting up vendor permissions.

An additional communication will be released when the submission period is opened in HQR.
