Subject: Update to Hospital-Specific Reports for Hybrid HWR and HWM Measures



The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) would like to notify users of an issue impacting the Hybrid Hospital Wide Readmission (HWR) and Hybrid Hospital Wide Mortality (HWM) Hospital-Specific Reports that were released on May 14, 2025. Specifically, the impacted reports are the ones which were calculated using claims and the submitted Core Clinical Data Elements (CCDE) and linking variables.

The Hospital-Specific reports are indicating that CCDE values are missing for excluded patients even though they were correctly submitted for these patients. This resulted in incorrect percentages of successfully linked vital signs and successfully linked laboratory test results to be calculated and displayed on the Hospital-Specific Reports.

A correction to this issue is in progress and updated reports will be released to the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) System. An additional notification will be sent when the reports are available.

As the HQR System continues to improve, any changes will be communicated.
