Review your Hospital-Specific Reports (HSRs) on the <u>Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR)</u> system for the Hospital Readmissions Reduction Program.

The Review and Correction period will begin August 12, 2025 and end September 10, 2025.

CMS encourages hospitals to review their HSRs and submit questions about their calculations as soon as possible. Submit all requests for corrections using the <u>QualityNet Question and Answer Tool</u> no later than 11:59 p.m. PT on September 10, 2025.

CMS released HSRs for the fiscal year (FY) 2026 Hospital Readmissions Reduction Program on Monday, August 11, 2025, via the HQR system. The Hospital Readmissions Reduction Program HSR contains information on hospital performance on six 30-day risk-standardized unplanned condition- or procedure-specific readmission measures and payment reduction status displayed on the *Measure detail dashboard* of the HQR system, as well as downloadable comma-separated values (CSV) files with your hospital's patient-level data. Hospital-level performance data is also available in downloadable portable document format (PDF) files. The report has an accompanying user guide with information about the contents of the HSR.

The following measures are included in the report:

Measure	
30-day risk-standardized unplanned condition- and procedure-specific readmission measures	
Acute myocardial infarction (AMI) readmission	
Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) readmission	
Heart failure (HF) readmission	
Pneumonia readmission	
Coronary artery bypass graft surgery (CABG) readmission	
Elective primary total hip and/or total knee arthroplasty (THA/TKA) readmission	

Performance periods

Your hospital's results for the FY 2026 program year are calculated using data from the following measure-specific performance periods:

30-day risk-standardized unplanned condition- or	July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2024
procedure-specific readmission measures	

Review and Correction period

The Review and Correction period enables hospitals to review the results in their HSR and submit questions about their calculations. Hospitals <u>cannot</u> request corrections to the underlying claims data or add new claims to the data extract during this period. Hospitals can review the data in their HSR and replicate their payment reduction and component results using the information in their HSR and accompanying user guide.

CMS encourages hospitals to review their HSR and submit questions about their calculations as soon as possible. Submit all requests for corrections using the <u>QualityNet Question and Answer Tool</u> between August 12, 2025 and 11:59 p.m. PT on September 10, 2025.

To submit a question using the QualityNet Question and Answer Tool, select "HRRP - Hospital Readmissions Reduction Program" from the program list and "HRRP review & correction request" as the topic. Hospitals should describe each discrepancy and include the following:

- CMS Certification Number (CCN)
- Hospital name
- Hospital address
- Contact's name, phone number, and email address
- Measure or component in question

Hospitals should not include personally identifiable information (PII) or protected health information (PHI) in their inquiry. When referring to the contents of the HSR, use the ID Number.
