Prospective Payment System-Exempt Cancer Hospital Facility-Specific Reports (FSRs) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 Program Year Now Available

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing facilities with FSRs containing information on the following measure for program year FY 2027:

Measure	Performance Period
PCH-36: 30-day Unplanned Readmissions for Cancer Patients (cancer readmissions measure)	October 1, 2024–September 30, 2025

An FSR provides your facility with an opportunity to review your results and understand your performance on the measure prior to public reporting in fall 2026. FSRs are available for viewing and download on CMS's [Hospital Quality Reporting system](#) Measure Detail Dashboard. National and facility-level performance data displayed on the dashboard can be downloaded as PDF and CSV files. Also available are patient-level CSV files that contain data used to calculate the measure results, and a User Guide to help interpret your FSR.
