"I love it when a plan comes together."

Whether you're hearing George Peppard or Liam Neeson in your head saying that line, you have to admit that having a plan come together is a good thing. ASCs need a plan, too – a reporting plan for entering data for ASC-8, Influenza Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel, to the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN). In order to successfully submit data for the 2017/2018 influenza season, you must first create a Monthly Reporting Plan.

To create a Reporting Plan, complete the following steps:

- 1. Access the SAMS.CDC.gov website, then log-in using the SAMS Grid Card option
- 2. Select **NHSN Reporting**
- 3. Click the second tab on the left, labeled Reporting Plan and then select Add
- 4. Enter a month and year for the current flu season (e.g., March 2018)
- 5. Click Ok on the popup window stating that no data have been entered yet
- 6. Check the box for Influenza Vaccination Summary and select Save
 - Once saved, the **HCW Plan Created Successfully** notification will appear at the top of the page

Once the Reporting Plan has been successfully added, navigate to the **Flu Summary** tab on the left and select **Add.** Then select **2017/2018** in the **Flu Season** drop-down menu. You are now ready to enter data!

Be sure to print and retain a copy of your completed submission; you can use the **Print Form** button on the top right of your screen. You can also find steps on how to verify your data in NHSN at https://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/pdfs/hps-manual/vaccination/verification-hcp-flu-data.pdf.
