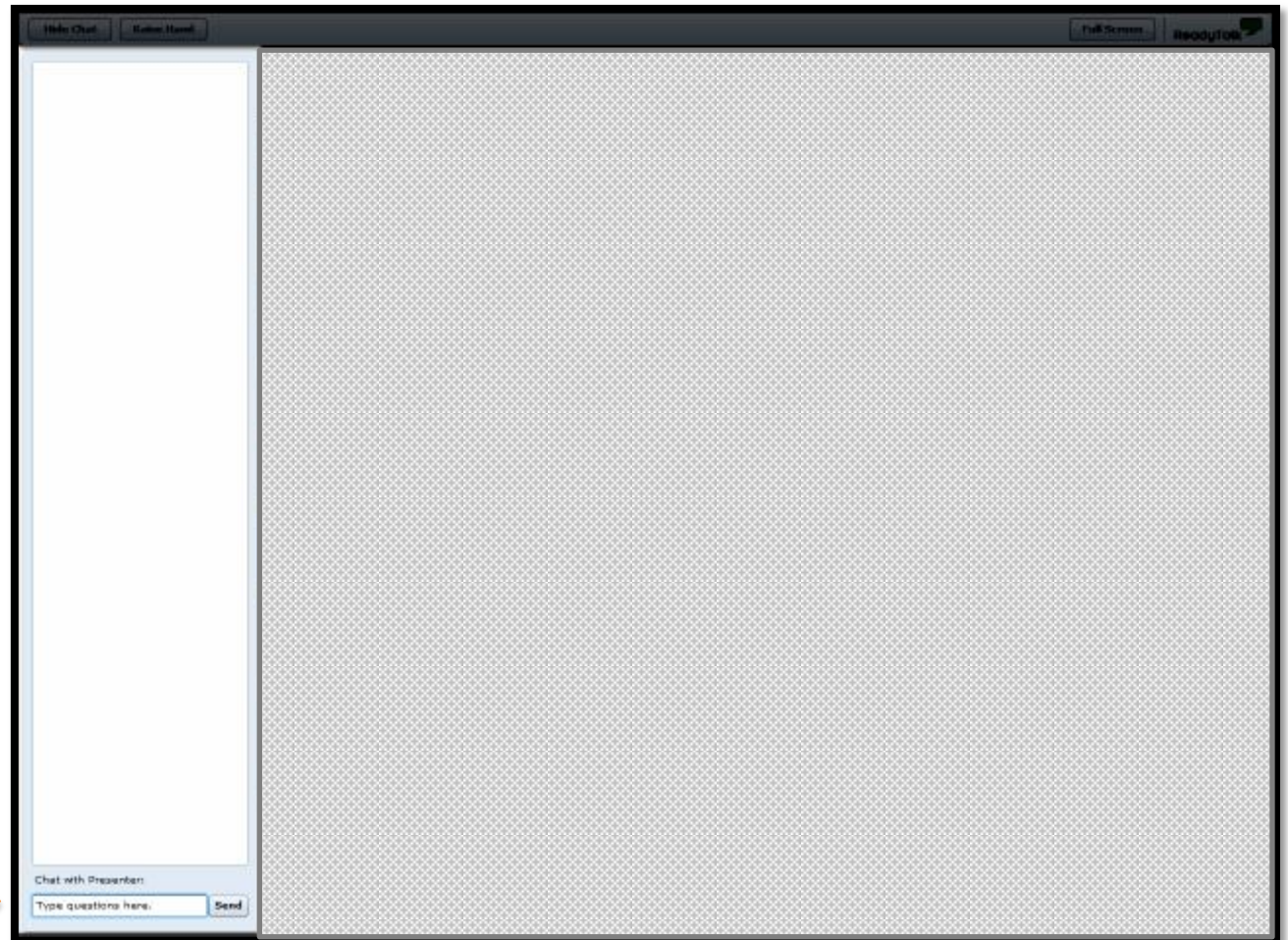

Hospitals - Outpatient

CART, the CMS Abstraction & Reporting Tool, is a powerful application for the collection and analysis of quality improvement data. Through data collection, retrospective analyses and real-time reporting, CART enables hospitals to comprehensively evaluate and manage quality improvement efforts. Whether a hospital is seeking Medicare certification or undertaking its own quality improvement initiatives, CART is ideal for the data collection and analyses that are essential to the success of all quality improvement efforts. The application is available at no charge to hospitals or other organizations seeking to improve the quality of care in the following clinical areas:

- Acute Myocardial Infarction
- Chest Pain
- Emergency Department (ED) – Throughput
- Pain Management
- Stroke
- Surgery*

CART-Outpatient is available for use on a stand-alone, Windows-based computer, in a computer network or in environments without computing resources (paper tool).

* Beginning January 1, 2015, the Surgery Measure Set has been removed. Data for the remainder of 2014 may be submitted until May 1, 2015.

Upgrading an Existing CART Installation

Compatibility: CART-Outpatient 1.12 is compatible with CART Outpatient 1.7 or newer versions. It is also compatible with CART Inpatient 4.11 or newer versions, and may be installed in the same directory.

If any compatible CART version (Inpatient or Outpatient) is installed on the workstation, follow these instructions to upgrade to CART-Outpatient 1.12:



Door to Evaluation Time Guidelines

HOSPITAL OQR PROVIDER CONTACT TIME: GUIDELINES

When abstracting door to evaluation times for OP-20 (Door to Diagnostic Evaluation by a Qualified Medical Professional):

- **REMEMBER** the definition of door to evaluation time: the time represented in hours and minutes for the first direct, personal exchange between an ambulatory patient and a physician or institutionally credentialed provider (i.e., medical personnel acting under the direct supervision of a physician for healthcare services, PA, APN) in the emergency department.
- There must be documentation of direct contact between the patient and the physician or institutionally credentialed provider.
- The exclusion guidelines for abstraction are provider-assigned time, admission time, arrival time, presentation time, and triage time.
- **DO** use a Nurses Note stating that there was contact, e.g., “MD in room for exam,” “MD at bedside,” etc.
- **DO** use a Medical Screening Exam (MSE) if it is substantiated by a documented physical exam.
- **DO NOT** use the time on H&P, history of present illness (HPI), order sheets, or any other physician-generated sheet, unless it specifically says that there was direct contact.

Note the following frequently asked questions:

QUESTION: Our event log states: “Seen by Provider at 08:00.” Can we use this time?
ANSWER: Yes. The time in the event log may be used as the provider contact time if there is substantiation that there was an exam, a note, or a comment by the provider in the record.

QUESTION: The provider documents: “Time seen: 08:00.” Can we use this time?
ANSWER: The patient’s time alone is not acceptable. If the time the exam was performed was 08:00, this time would be acceptable. “Time seen,” as entered on the event log, must refer to the time of the provider’s first direct contact with the patient.

QUESTION: What are some of the terms we can use for door to diagnostic evaluation by the physician/APN/PA or institutionally credentialed provider?
ANSWER: Some acceptable phrases are:

<input type="radio"/> Provider contact time	<input type="radio"/> Resident provider contact
<input type="radio"/> Patient medically screened	<input type="radio"/> Attending provider contact

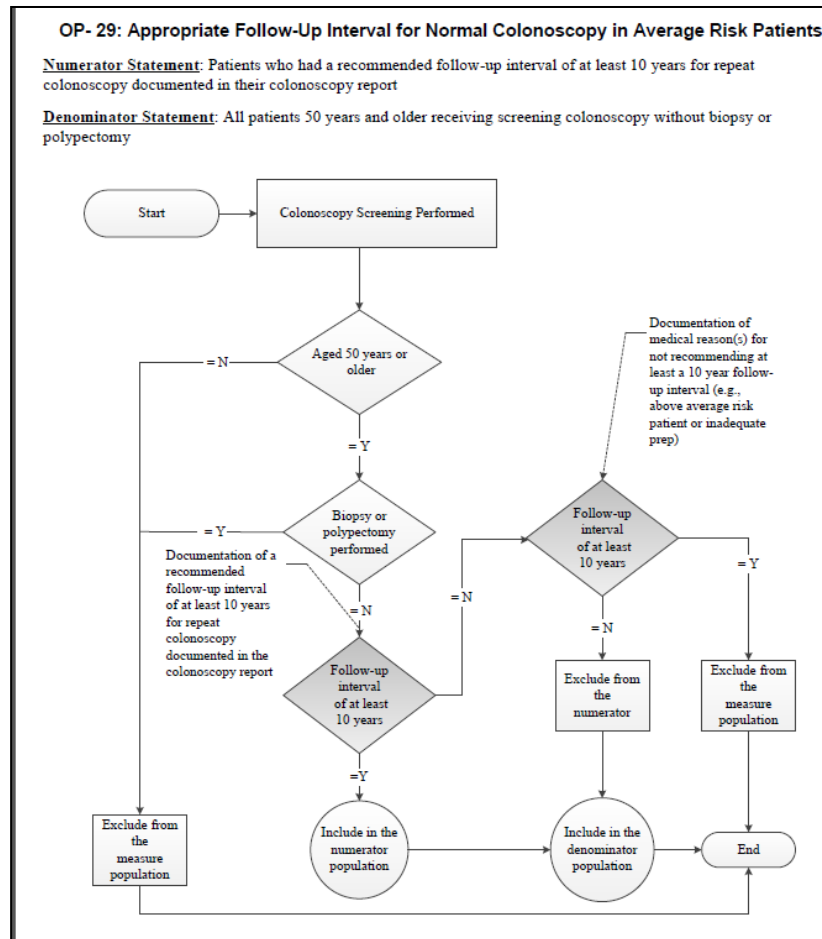

Endoscopy Tool

OP- 29: Appropriate Follow-Up Interval for Normal Colonoscopy in Average Risk Patients

Numerator Statement: Patients who had a recommended follow-up interval of at least 10 years for repeat colonoscopy documented in their colonoscopy report

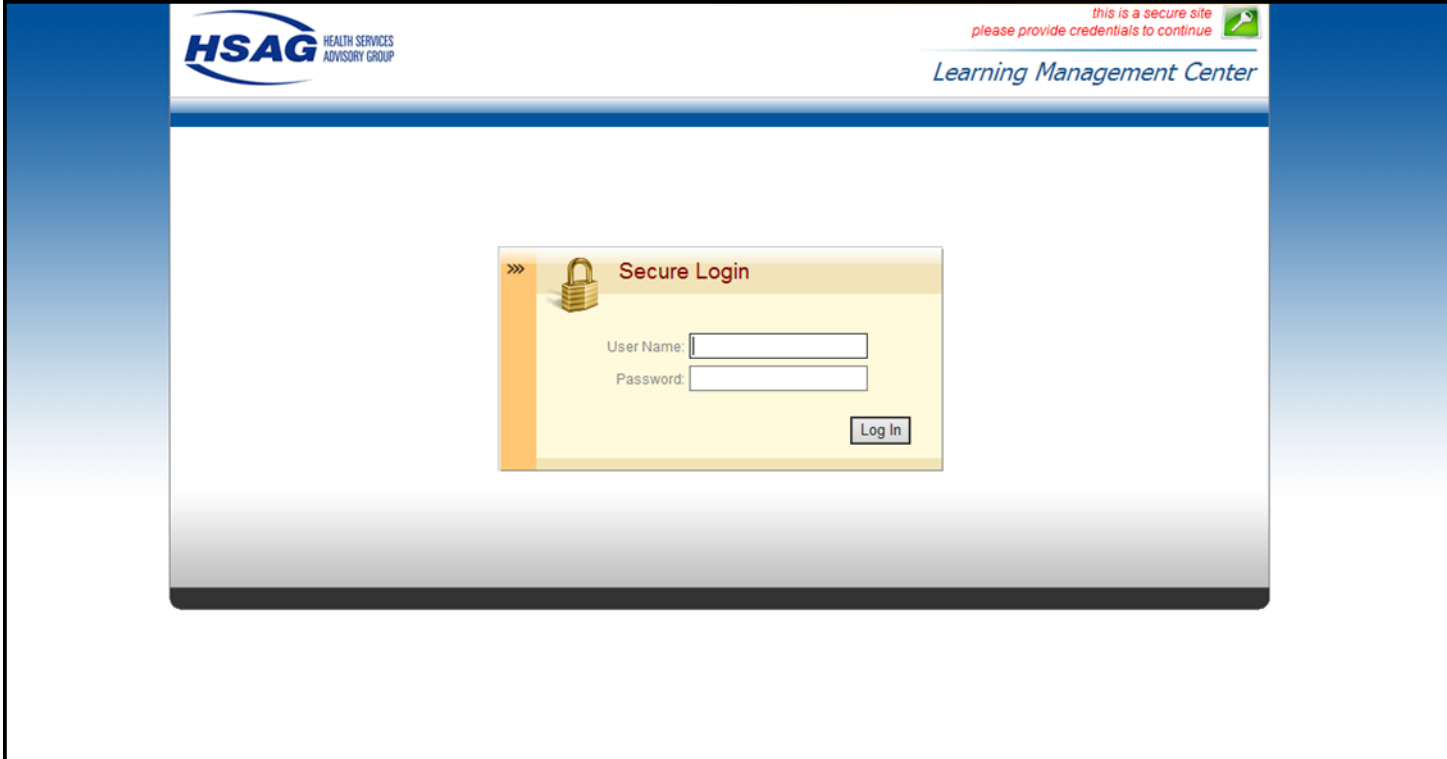
