Question:	Is there an amount of hours that qualify for "one working day"?
Answer:	No. Working in the facility for any part of one day counts as a working day.
Question:	If an employee works part-time for my facility and part-time for another facility, do both facilities count that individual on their surveys?
Answer:	Yes. As long as they work at each facility for one day or more during the reporting period, you would count that individual for each facility.
Question:	HCP Safety reporting plan, what is that for? I thought we only report once on the website. I do not recall sending these forms last year.
Answer:	The reporting plan is required every year. You may know it as your monthly reporting plan.
Question:	Do we need to account for reps?
Answer:	No. You would not include vendors in your data, not even in your other contract personnel category.



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Question:	This is done on the NHSN website, right?
Answer:	Correct. You submit your data online at the NHSN website at <u>cdc.gov/NHSN</u> . You would then select the NHSN Member Login box if you are a registered user, or select New to NHSN? Enroll Facility Here box to register your facility.
Question:	If a volunteer or observer has not had the flu vaccine, is the ASC obligated to administer the vaccine to these non-employees?
Answer:	No. ASCs are not obligated to administer flu vaccine to anyone as part of this NHSN reporting. The only requirement would be to report that person as unvaccinated.
Question:	Is this CEU peer-reviewed?
Answer:	There is a CE offered for the professional entities noted on the first slide of the Continuing Education information.
