**1** Move your mouse over the **WebEx Navigation Panel** at the top of your screen. The menu will drop-down.

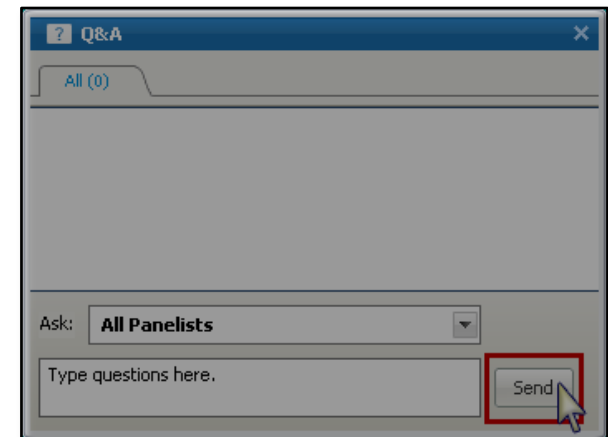


**2** Click the **Q&A** icon. The Q&A panel will display on your screen.

# Influenza Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel

The HCP Influenza Vaccination Summary Measure is designed to:

- Ensure that reporting of influenza vaccination coverage among healthcare personnel data is consistent over time within a single healthcare facility and comparable across facilities
- Allow staff members in healthcare facilities to use the Influenza Vaccination Summary to monitor influenza vaccination percentages among HCP

# NHSN Enrollment

- Facilities not currently participating with NHSN who wish to participate must enroll.
  - Visit [www.cdc.gov/nhsn/enrollment/index.html](http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/enrollment/index.html) for details regarding the enrollment process.
  - Email [nhsn@cdc.gov](mailto:nhsn@cdc.gov) to confirm enrollment status if you are unsure.
- If an IPF is located within an acute care/critical access hospital, the facility should be added as a unit *within* the already enrolled acute care/critical access hospital.

# Activating the HPS Component in NHSN

If a facility is already enrolled in NHSN and wishes to participate in the HPS Component, the facility must ***activate*** that component within NHSN.



# Denominator Reporting Requirement: Inclusions

- **Required**
  - Employees (staff on facility payroll)
  - Licensed Independent Practitioners
  - Adult students/trainees and volunteers
- **Optional**
  - Other contract personnel

# Numerator Reporting Requirement: Inclusions

Numerator reporting requirement inclusions for the HCP measure consist of HCP who:

- Received an influenza vaccination at the reporting healthcare facility since the influenza vaccine became available this season
- Provided a written report or documentation of receiving an influenza vaccination outside the reporting healthcare facility since the influenza vaccine became available this season
- Have a medical contraindication to the influenza vaccine
- Declined to receive the influenza vaccine
- Have an unknown vaccination status (or criteria not met for above-mentioned categories)

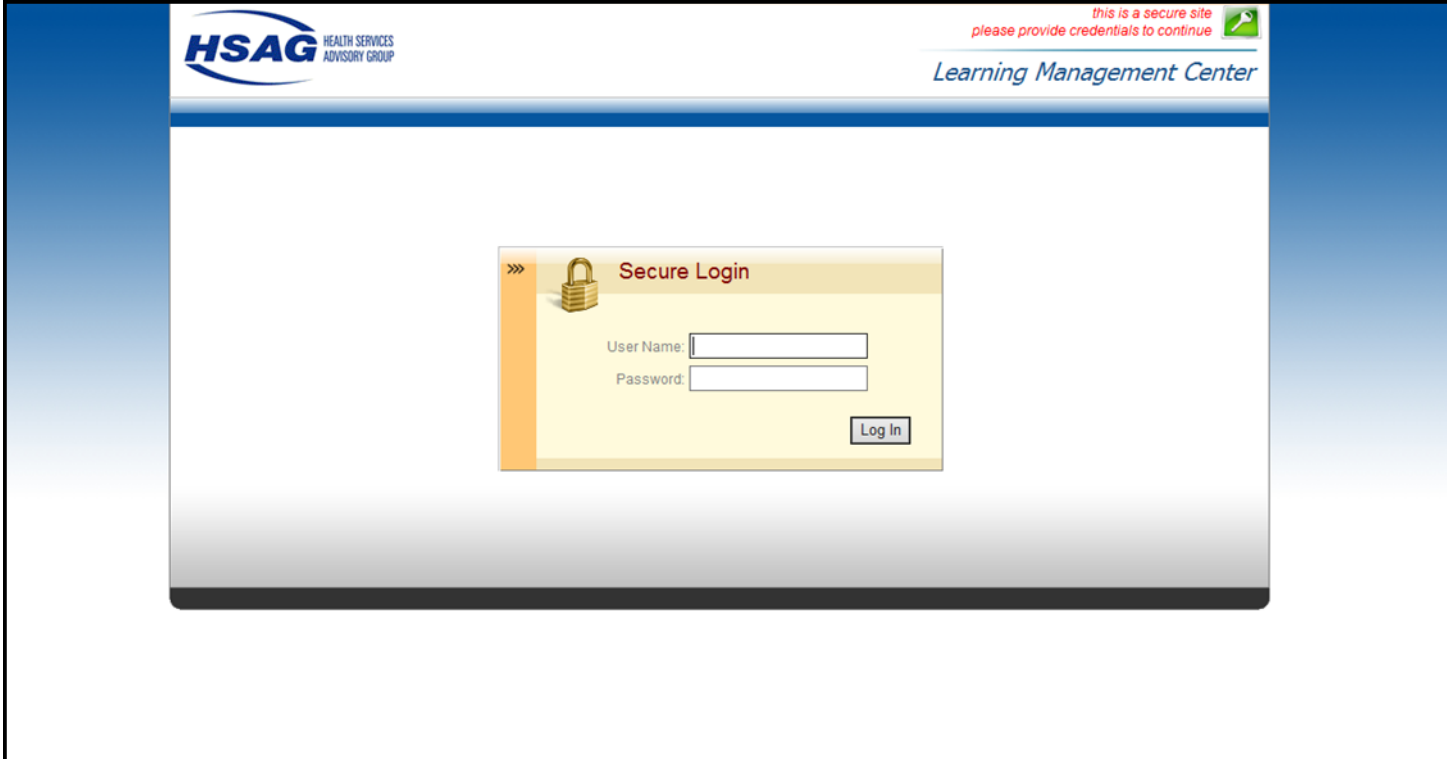
