


Troubleshooting Audio

Location of Audio Controls



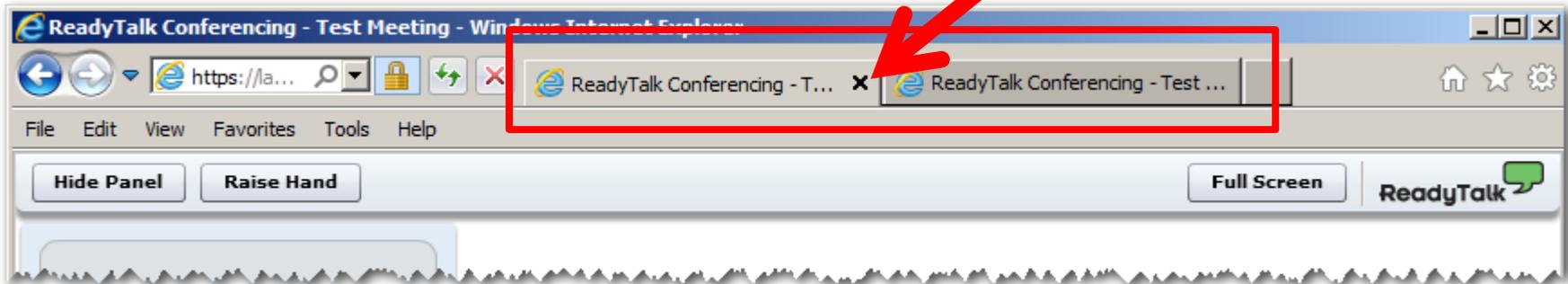

What is PSVA?

The PSVA:

- Is a downloadable tool that operates on a User's system
- Was developed in response to interest and demand from the quality reporting (QR) community to validate QRDA Category I files
- Was piloted by the QR community in 2015

PSVA's Benefits


The PSVA:

- Allows submitters to catch and correct errors prior to data submission to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)
- Provides validation feedback within the submitter's system
- Allows valid files to be separated and submitted while invalid files are identified for error correction

Overview of the PSVA Process

The Vendor or care delivery organization, also known as the User:

1. Downloads the PSVA to their system
2. Validates quality submission files locally using the Pre-Submission Validation Method
3. Receives immediate quality submission error feedback
4. Submits valid quality reporting submissions



Technical Requirements

To utilize the PSVA, organizations must:

- Create Quality Reporting Data Architecture (QRDA) Category I files based on the Health Level 7 (HL7) Base Standard for QRDA and the CMS QRDA Implementation Guide (IG)
- Download and install the PSVA to their system
 - Requires a QualityNet Secure Portal (QSP) User Account
- Submit Files
 - Requires a QSP User Account with an Electronic Health Record (EHR) Data Upload role





PSVA Architecture





Downloading the PSVA Tool


1. Click on **[PSVA_DOWNLOAD]** directory in the Navigation Section on the left pane. The **psva_tool_1.1.zip** will appear in the details section on the right pane. (see next page)

2. Select the **[psva-tool-1.1.zip]** and click on the **[Download]** button on the top of the screen to download the PSVA tool.




Downloading the PSVA Tool (cont.)

3. Save the file to your user directory by selecting the **[Save as]** option.



4. Select a location within your user directory on the **[Save As]** window.

5. Click on **[Open folder]** to navigate to the folder to which the PSVA was saved.





1. Open the extracted folder and double click on **[launchPSVATool.bat]**.

2. Alternatively, you may open PSVA using the command prompt after the download has completed by:
 - a. Typing “cmd” into a windows search and pressing **[enter]**
 - b. Typing “cd <path to extracted PSVA folder>”
 - c. Typing “start javaw -jar psva-application-gui-1.1.jar -Xms1024m -Xmx2048m”


The User:

- Must have an EHR Data Upload role assigned to their QSP credentials
- Will be prompted to enter a valid CMS *QualityNet* User ID and password combination
 - The same credentials that the user used to login into QSP
- May also click the **[Login]** button to get the login prompt.



Select a Program

After a successful User login to the application, the **[Program Selection]** drop-down menu is enabled.





Add Files

1. Select the **[Add Files]** button.




a. The **[File Selection]** window will open.

2. Navigate to a location where the Zip files are stored on the workstation.
 - a. **The current version of the PSVA tool only accepts Zip files.**
3. Select one or more files to add to the application and select the **[Open]** button.
 - a. This pop-up message will appear.



4. Click **[OK]** to view the selected Zip files that were added to the file details table within the PSVA tool.

5. The status of the files within the PSVA tool will be reflected as **New**.





 - a. During validation, a progress bar will be shown to indicate the progress of the validation.



- b. After the validation is completed, the following pop-up will appear.



3. Click **[OK]**.

4. The File Details Table will be updated with the **Status of Validation** (Valid or Invalid) in the status column.

5. A Feedback File is generated for each of the Zip files and a hyperlink under the Feedback File column is provided.


1. Select one or more valid files to submit to CMS

 - i. Submits validated files to the CMS' **Test** directory for the selected program
 - b. **[Submit Production Files to CMS]** button to start the submission process
 - a. Submits validated files to the CMS' **Production** directory for the selected program







On Demand Version Check

Check the version being used by the validators at any time by clicking the **[Version Check]** button within the PSVA tool.




Note: The application does not work with an out-of-date tool version. A User is allowed to validate a file using an out-of-date validator but cannot submit files to CMS.

If the tool and the validator's version are current, the following message will display.



Update the Validators

1. If there is an update available to one or more validators, the user will be prompted with an option to update the validator(s).




2. If the user chooses to not update the validator, they will have the option of validating the files using an older version of the validator.
 - a. Files validated using an older version of the validator cannot be submitted to CMS.
 - b. If you choose to update the validator(s), the PSVA tool will automatically update the validator(s).
3. After a successful update, the following validator updated successfully message will be presented on the screen.



Update the PSVA Tool

1. If there is an update available for the PSVA tool, the User will be prompted with an option to update the Tool.




2. The User can then download the newer version of the Tool from CMS after logging into the QSP's Secure File Transfer Application.

Note: If the user chooses to not update the Tool when a newer version is available, they will not be able to perform any functions within the PSVA tool.

PSVA Licensing Agreement

Review the PSVA Licensing Agreement by clicking the **[Licensing Agreement]** button within the PSVA Tool.



Clicking the **[PSVA Licensing Agreement]** button will cause the PSVA Licensing Agreement to appear.

Frequently Asked Questions

Question 1: *Does PSVA need to be integrated with my EHR?*

Answer 1: No, PSVA can be run as a desktop application on your workstation.

Question 2: *What eCQM specifications do my files need to adhere to?*

Answer 2: None. The PSVA tool does not perform measure verification or calculate outcomes. QRDA files may contain any eCQM version.

Question 3: *Is production data required or will test data be allowed?*

Answer 3: PSVA is able to validate files containing test or production data.

Frequently Asked Questions Cont.

Question 4: *What QRDA standards will the Tool validate against?*

Answer 4: The PSVA tool will validate against HL7 QRDA Cat I R3 Base Standard and most of the 2016 CMS IG rules.

Question 5: *If my file passes PSVA validation, does that mean it will pass CMS validation?*

Answer 5: Not necessarily. The CMS system will perform validations in addition to those performed by PSVA, such as CCN and eCQM verifications. Therefore, a file that passes PSVA validation may not be accepted by the CMS system.

Question 6: *Does PSVA provide measure calculations?*

Answer 6: PSVA does not currently provide any measure calculations or measure data checks. That information will need to be obtained by submission of either test or production files through the *QualityNet Secure Portal*.




