PCHQR Program: FY 2016 IPPS/LTCH Final Rule Questions and Answers

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Question 1: I am assuming that since the SCIP measures will be retired, reporting

of pop/sampling counts will also stop after submitting Q2 and Q3

2015 discharges?

Answer 1: As indicated in the Fiscal Year 2016 Final Rule, reporting of the SCIP

measures as part of the PCHQR Program will cease with third quarter 2015. There will be no SCIP reporting starting with fourth quarter

2015, including population and sampling counts.

Question 2: Does this presentation pertain to IPPS facilities or only PCHQR?

Answer 2: These measures and reporting requirements are specific only to the 11

hospitals billing Medicare as PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospitals. There are – referring readers to the applicable section of the Federal Register – other sections specific to IPPS, LTCH (long-term care hospitals), and other types of providers billing Medicare. This is specific only to

the 11 PPS-Exempt Cancer Hospitals.
