CY 2023 Hospital OPPS/ASC Payment System Proposed Rule: Streaming Through the Rule Question & Answer Summary Document

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Subject-matter experts researched and answered the following questions during the live webinar. The questions may have been edited for grammar.



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Question 1:	Does the Rural Emergency Hospital Quality Reporting (REHQR) Program apply to critical access hospitals (CAHs)?
	The new REHQR Program is being established as mandated by e the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021. In this legislation, Congress established a new Medicare provider type: Rural Emergency Hospitals (REHs). Hospitals eligible to convert to REH status can be: A facility that was a CAH with not more than 50 beds <u>or</u> a subsection (d) hospital with not more than 50 beds that is considered as being located in a rural area. Details regarding these specification are outlined in the <u>CY 2023</u> <u>Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS)/ Ambulatory Surgical</u> <u>Center (ASC) Payment System Proposed Rule</u> , Section XVI.
Question 2:	What is the starting date for the mandatory reporting period for OP-40, the ST-Elevation Myocardial Infarction (STEMI) electronic clinical quality measure (eCQM)?
	The data submission deadline for eCQMs will be May 15th. However, if the submission deadline falls on a nonwork day, that is, occurring on a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday, or on any other day all in part of which is declared to be a nonwork day for Federal employees may be moved to the first day that is not a nonwork day. For example, if May 15 th falls on a Saturday, the deadline would be moved to Monday, May 17 th . Data submission for the voluntary period for OP-40 will begin with the calendar year (CY) 2023 reporting period with mandatory reporting beginning with CY 2024 reporting period/CY 2026 payment determination.
Question 3:	Will CMS publicly report the data submitted during the voluntarily reporting period for OP-37 a–e, Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems Outpatient and Ambulatory Surgery Survey (OAS CARPS), and OP-40?
	Yes, CMS may publicly report any data submitted, required or voluntary.
