05/01/16	<p>Submitting Q4 2015 Inpatient Population and Sampling Counts through the Secure Portal</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to the <i>QualityNet Secure Portal</i>. 2. Select <i>Hospital Quality Reporting: IQR, OQR, ASCQR, IPFQR, PCHQR</i> from the <i>Quality Programs</i> drop-down menu. 3. Look for <i>Hospital Reporting Inpatient/Outpatient</i>; select <i>View/Edit Population & Sampling</i>. 4. Select <i>Inpatient Population & Sampling</i>. 5. Enter your facility's CCN; click <i>Continue</i>. 6. Select Reporting Period Q4 2015; click <i>Continue</i>. 7. Check "boxes" for completion: The AMI, Global, SEP, STK, and VTE measure sets contain required measures, and no boxes should be blank (all are required even if submitting eCQMs). Note: If your facility submits case counts for AMI, Global, SEP, STK, and VTE, ensure that the numbers entered meet the Sampling Criteria thresholds. 	<input type="checkbox"/>						
05/15/16	<p>Checking Submission of Q4 2015 Inpatient Data</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to the <i>QualityNet Secure Portal</i>. 2. Select <i>Run Reports</i> from the <i>My Reports</i> drop-down menu. 3. Select <i>IQR</i> from the <i>Report Program</i> drop-down menu; then select <i>Hospital Reporting – Feedback Reports</i>; then select <i>View Reports</i>. 4. Run the <i>Case Status Summary Report</i> for Q4 2015. 5. Review to check that all the cases submitted have been accepted. 6. Run the <i>Submission Detail Report</i> to review specific cases; resubmit any applicable cases. 7. Run and review your hospital's PPR to ensure all IQR requirements have been met: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Go to <i>Run Reports</i>. B. Select <i>IQR Program</i> and category: <i>Hospital Reporting – Annual Payment Update</i>. C. Click <i>View Reports</i> and select <i>Hospital Reporting – Provider Participation Report</i>. D. Select CY 2015; then select <i>Discharge Quarter Q4 2015</i>; click <i>Run Report</i>. E. View the PPR for the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Active QualityNet Security Administrator</i> should display as <i>Yes</i>. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Completed Structural Measures</i> should display as <i>Yes</i>. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Data Accuracy and Completeness Acknowledgement</i> should display as <i>Yes</i>. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Intent to Submit</i>: If your hospital submitted eCQMs, this should display <i>Yes</i>. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>EHR Measure Sets Submitted</i>: If your hospital submitted eCQMs, this should display <i>Yes</i>. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Total Patient Population and Total Sample Size</i> columns case counts will display using <i>Population and Sampling</i> data. <i>No</i> means no counts have been submitted. Hospitals with no discharges for a required measure set must enter a zero (0). <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Total Cases Accepted</i> column should be \geq your <i>Total Patient Population</i> and/or <i>Total Medicare Claims Accepted</i> column, unless you are electing to sample. If your hospital is sampling, ensure the <i>Total Cases Accepted</i> are \geq the minimum sample requirement. Note: If your hospital submitted eCQMs instead, this column will show zeros. <input type="checkbox"/> Measure Set: IQR-ED and IQR-IMM Case Counts <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. IMM and ED must have at least the minimum number of cases each as the global population. ii. If your report displays <i>No</i> in the <i>Total Patient Population</i> and <i>Total Sample Size</i> columns, it means you have not entered your <i>Global Population and Sampling</i> data. iii. If the <i>Total Cases Accepted</i> column is blank, it means you have not submitted IMM and/or ED data. Hospitals are required to submit these global measures. Hospitals that do not have an ED may submit an IPPS Measure Exception Form; otherwise, they must submit ED files each discharge quarter. <input type="checkbox"/> PC-01 (<i>Web-based Measure</i>): Numbers or zeroes are acceptable. If your report displays <i>No</i>, these data have not been entered. Hospitals that do not deliver babies may submit an IPPS Measure Exception Form; otherwise, they must enter zeroes every quarter. <input type="checkbox"/> Yes should display for all IQR HAI (Healthcare-Associated Infection) Quality Measure Data: <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td><input type="checkbox"/> <i>C. difficile</i></td> <td><input type="checkbox"/> CLABSI</td> <td><input type="checkbox"/> SSI Abd Hyst</td> </tr> <tr> <td><input type="checkbox"/> CAUTI</td> <td><input type="checkbox"/> MRSA Bacteremia</td> <td><input type="checkbox"/> SSI Colon</td> </tr> </table> If Yes is not displayed, check that your hospital has correctly entered all IQR NHSN data. Refer to the NHSN Monthly Checklist for Reporting to CMS Hospital IQR or contact the NHSN Help Desk. <input type="checkbox"/> <i>Healthcare Personnel Influenza Vaccination</i> should display as No. The yearly summary for the 2015–2016 flu season (October 1, 2015–March 31, 2016) will be displayed on the PPR for Q1 2016.
